

Alliance Ohio May 10th 1897.

City Council met in regular session with President Morgan in the Chair and the following members present. Kay, King, Lorr, Miller, Russell, Scott, Seranton, Trail, Williams.

Minutes of the preceding meeting read and approved.

A. Petition signed by a number of the property owners abutting on the first Alley north of and parallel with Broadway between Freedom and Arch Avenues asking the Council to build a Sanitary sewer in said Alley was read and on motion of Lorr seconded by Wilson the matter was referred to the sewer Committee.

Engineer Fouts reported that the necessary tiling to drain Rosenberg street near the Shilling lot would cost about \$135.00 and on motion of Scott seconded by Williams the report was accepted and the matter referred to the Sewer and Finance Committees with power to act.

King moved that the Sewer Contractors be ordered to put the Alley near Broadway in proper condition seconded by Scott and carried.

Miller moved that the crossing at the intersection of Franklin Ave and the first Alley north of Patterson Street be repaired seconded by Trail the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Kay, King, Lorr, Miller, Russell, Scott, Seranton, Trail, Williams, Morgan yeas 10 nays none the motion declared passed.

On motion of Russell seconded by Trail the Clerk was instructed to notify the Street Railway Co to clean off their Poles along Main street.

Kay called the Council's attention to the condition the rear end of Mrs Marchands lot was left in when the City graded the Alley and moved that the Street Commission be instructed to place wooden steps at the rear of the lot and also lower the coal door ^{in coal house} seconded by Seranton the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Kay, King, Lorr, Miller, Russell, Scott, Seranton, Trail, Williams, Morgan yeas 10 nays none the motion was declared passed.

On motion of Seranton seconded by King the property owners on High street were granted permission to improve the street between Union Ave and Park Ave by grading the same at their own expense, the work to be done under the instructions of the City Civil Engineer.

Resolutions to
amend Sanitary
sewer System

The following Resolutions were presented and read:

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance Ohio, That the plan of the Sanitary sewer system in this City be amended, by extending Lateral sewer No 24 from the first Alley south of Columbia street, to Broadway street, in the Alley between and running parallel to Seneca and Liberty Corners. Forward the adoption of the resolution seconded by Williams the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Kay, King, Love, Miller, Russell, Scott, Seranton, Trail, Williams, Morgan yeas 10 nays none and the resolution was declared adopted.

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance Ohio, That the plan of the Sanitary sewer system in this City be amended by extending Lateral sewer No 24 from sewer No 17 in Arch Avenue to Freedom Avenue in the Alley between and parallel to Broadway and Columbia streets. For the adoption of the resolution seconded by Seranton the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Kay, King, Love, Miller, Russell, Scott, Seranton, Trail, Williams, Morgan yeas 10 nays none and the resolution was declared adopted.

Resolution to
improve certain
alleys by sewerage.

A. Resolution to improve certain alleys by sewerage. was read as follows: Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance Ohio, that it is hereby declared necessary to make certain improvements by excavating and laying sewer pipe according to the plans, specifications and profile relating to the same now on file in the City Engineer's office, along the following streets and alleys; commencing at the manhole at the intersection of Arch street and the first alley parallel with and north of Broadway; thence east along said alley to Freedom street; also commencing at a manhole at the intersection of the alley south of Columbia street and the alley east of Seneca street; thence south in the alley east of Seneca street to the north line of Broadway. The cost and expense of said improvements shall be assessed per front foot upon the lots and lands abutting on said improvement, according to the laws and ordinances on the subject of assessments, and shall be payable in three annual installments, and bonds shall be issued in anticipation of the collection of such assessments. The Clerk is hereby directed to cause this resolution to be published for two weeks in a newspaper

published and of general circulation in the Corporation. Lov moved the adoption of the resolution seconded by Seranton the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Kay, King, Lov, Miller, Russell, Scott, Seranton, Trail, Williams, Morgan yeas 10 nays none and the resolution was declared adopted.

Engineers report

Engineer Fouts reported that it would cost the City a large sum of money to build a storm water sewer at the Culvert under the Fort Wayne tracks near Arch Avenue and even that would not obviate the bad odor complained of in warm weather and he also stated that the place complained of was on the Rail Road Co's ground,

on motion of Seranton seconded by Trail the report was accepted. Lov moved that the sidewalk committee authorized to have all sidewalks thrown out that were in a dangerous condition seconded by Kay the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Kay, King, Lov, Miller, Russell, Scott, Seranton, Trail, Williams, Morgan yeas 10 nays none, the motion was declared passed.

On motion of Russell seconded by Seranton the Finance Committee was instructed to place a certain amount of money in the sidewalk fund.

Sidewalk Resolution

Russell offered the following resolution and moved its adoption: Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance Ohio, that it is necessary, and that a sidewalk 6 feet wide, and of flag stone or brick shall be constructed along the east end of Lot 2156 to the established grade, and in accordance with the ordinances of this City. And the Mayor is hereby instructed to cause written notice to be served upon the owner of said premises of the passage of this resolution. Williams seconded the motion to adopt the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Kay, King, Lov, Miller, Russell, Scott, Seranton, Trail, Williams, Morgan yeas 10 nays none and the resolution was declared adopted.

On motion of Seranton seconded by Scott the grade on Rosenberg street was referred to the Committee on grades and City Engineer.

Report on Rules
for 1897-98

Kay read the following report: To the City Council: Gentlemen: Your special Committee directed to report to this Council certain Rules for its guidance during

the ensuing year by leave to recommend the adoption of the Rules in force during the past year and further that Rule 1st be amended to read as follows;

Rule 1. Regular meetings of the Council shall be held at the Council Chamber, City Hall, the first and third Monday evenings of each month, at half past seven O'clock from April to September inclusive, and at seven O'clock from October to March inclusive, unless otherwise ordered by the Council. On motion of Russell seconded by Trail the special committee report on Rules was adopted.

King moved that the Clerk be instructed to have the rules governing the Council and the standing committees for the ensuing year printed seconded by Seranton the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Kay, King, Lorr, Miller, Russell, Scott, Seranton, Trail, Williams, Morgan, yeas 10 nays none and the motion was declared passed.

On motion of Lorr seconded by Kay the matter of damages to Blisha Teeters property on Linden Avenue was referred to the Judiciary Committee and City Solicitor.

On motion of Trail Council adjourned.
