

Alliance Ohio June 21st 1897.

Alliance City Council met in regular session with president Morgan in the chair and the following members present, Conger, Kay, King, Love, Miller, Russell, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Williams

Minutes of the preceding meeting read and approved.

Agreement between
Wm Kelly and the
City of Alliance.

An agreement between William Kelly and the City of Alliance was read, in which the City agreed to fill the run across the Kelly's lot situated on north West Ave and on motion of Miller seconded by King the work was ordered done as stated in the agreement.

Repair Bridge
on Freedom Street.

On motion of Russell seconded by Trail the Street Commissioner was instructed to make the necessary repairs on the Bridge located on Freedom Ave near Mr. Scanlon's Property.

Park Avenue.

Scranton called the Council's attention to the condition of Park Ave near the Randall property and moved that the matter be referred to the Street Committee seconded by Trail and carried.

St Railway Co
to lower Track.

Conger moved that the Street Railway Co be granted permission to lower their track 3 or 4 inches on Union Avenue under the Railroad Bridge, the work to be done under the supervision of the City Civil Engineer seconded by Scranton and carried.

Clerk notify
Contractors to repair
Crossings on Park Ave.

Russell moved that the Clerk notify the Contractor of the new Christian Church to repair the crossings that were damaged, laying a sewer under the same seconded by Conger and carried.

St. Commissioner
to repair Crossings

On motion of Scranton seconded by Trail the Street Commissioner was instructed to repair a number of crossings on Park Ave.

Clerk to advertise
for Bid. for Lateral
sewer and Sale of
Bonds

On motion of Love seconded by Trail the Clerk was instructed to advertise for bids to build lateral sewer no 24, and for the sale of Bonds that the City is about to issue.

Election of J. A.
Mattick engineer
at Disposal Works.

Conger stated that the Supt of the Sewage Disposal Works time would expire the first of July, and that it would be necessary to elect some person tonight as the year would expire before our next regular meeting, and Conger moved that the Council retire to the Clerk's office for the purpose of selecting a candidate seconded by Trail and carried.

The Council retired to the Clerk's office and upon

returning Conger placed in nomination J. A. Matticks to act as Engineer at the Disposal Works for the ensuing year, at the same salary received by J. M. English seconded by Trail the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Ray, King, Love, Miller, Russell, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Williams, Morgan, yeas 11 nays none and J. A. Matticks was declared elected. Trail moved that the City Civil Engineer act as Supt of the Sewage Disposal Works seconded by King and carried.

Sidewalk on Grant Street.

On motion of Scott seconded by Williams the sidewalk along the Hudson property on Grant street was referred to the sidewalk Committee.

Sidewalk Resolution.

Trail offered the following resolution and moved its adoption. Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance, Ohio, that it is necessary, and that a sidewalk six feet wide, and of flag stone or brick shall be constructed along the south ends of lots 570 and 571 to the established grade, and in accordance with the ordinances of this City. And the Mayor is hereby instructed to cause written notice to be served upon the owner of said premises of the passage of this resolution. Conger seconded the motion to adopt the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Ray, King, Love, Miller, Russell, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Williams, Morgan, yeas 11 nays none and the resolution was declared adopted.

On motion of Love seconded by Russell the Street Commissioner was instructed to take the plank to the Disposal Works that were taken from a walk on Wester Avenue.

Repair Main st.

Love stated to the Council that the Property owners on Main Street had raised money to repair the street and moved that they be given permission to do so, the work to be done under the supervision of the City Civil Engineer, and without cost to the City seconded by Russell and carried.

Injunction Case

Solicitor Crain called the Council's attention to the injunction that had been served on the City by the Lexington Township Trustees.

King moved that the Solicitor be instructed to defend

the City in the case and if necessary secure Judge Thayer of Canton to assist him seconded by Williams. the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, King, Miller, Scott, Williams, Morgan nays Kay, Lov, Russell, Scranton, Trail, yeas 6 nays 5 and the motion was declared passed.

An Ordinance entitled an ordinance to provide for the issuing of the Bonds of the City of Alliance, Ohio, for the purpose of Constructing Sewer No 24 was read the first time and Lov moved that the rules be suspended and the ordinance be read the second time by title seconded by Trail the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Kay, King, Lov, Miller, Russell, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Williams, Morgan ^{yeas 11} nays none, the rules were declared suspended, and the ordinance was read the second time by title, and Lov moved that the rules be again suspended and the ordinance read the third time by title seconded by Williams the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Kay, King, Lov, Miller, Russell, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Williams, Morgan yeas 11 nays none the rules were declared suspended and the ordinance was read the third time by title and Lov moved that the ordinance be placed on its final passage seconded by Williams the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Kay, King, Lov, Miller, Russell, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Williams, Morgan yeas 11 nays none and the ordinance was declared passed.

An Ordinance to establish the grade on Prospect street from the east curb line of Union Avenue to the west curb line of Mechanic Avenue was read the first time and Scranton moved that the rules be suspended and the ordinance be read the second time by title seconded by King the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Kay, King, Lov, Miller, Russell, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Williams, Morgan yeas 11 nays none, the rules were declared suspended and the ordinance was read the second time by title and Scranton moved that the rules be again suspended and the ordinance read the third time by title seconded by Trail the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Kay, King, Lov, Miller, Russell, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Williams, Morgan yeas 11 nays none the rules were declared suspended and the ordinance was read the third time by title and Scranton moved that the ordinance be placed on its passage seconded by Williams the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Kay, King, Lov,

Miller, Russell, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Williams, Morgan yeas 11 nays none and the ordinance was declared passed.

Grade on Rosenberg street

On motion of Scranton seconded by King the Rosenberg street grade ordinance was taken from the table. Scranton moved that the rules be suspended and the ordinance be read the second time by title seconded by King the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Kay, King, Scranton, Trail, Morgan Nays Love, Miller, Scott, ^{Passage} Williams yeas 6 nays 5 and the motion to suspend the rules was declared lost.

J. M. English to have garden at Disposal works.

Kay stated to the Council that Mr English had made a garden on the City ground at the Disposal Works and moved that J. M. English be granted permission to use the same as it matures, seconded by Conger and carried.

Conger moved that when this Council adjourns that it adjourns to meet on Tuesday evening July 6th 1897. seconded by King and carried.

No further business Council adjourned.
