

Alliance Ohio July 6th 1897.

City Council met in regular session with President Morgan in the Chair and the following members present Conger, King, Lorr, Miller, Russell, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Wilson,

Minutes of the preceding meeting read and approved. Mayor's Report for the month of June was read, showing fines and licenses collected to the amount of twelve dollars, and on motion of Conger seconded by Miller the report was accepted and ordered placed on file.

Lorr of the Finance Committee stated that the Committee had met and approved a number of claims against the City, and asked the Clerk to read the same, the Bills were read, and Lorr moved that an ordinance be prepared for their payment, the Ordinance being prepared was read, and Lorr moved that the Ordinance be placed on its passage seconded by King the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, King, Lorr, Miller, Russell, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Wilson, Morgan yeas 10 nays none and the Ordinance was declared passed.

Scott moved that J. C. Craven be granted permission to set the platform of his Scales four feet out on the sidewalk in front of his property on Market Street, seconded by Scranton the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas King, Lorr, Scott, Scranton, Wilson. nays Conger, Miller, Russell, Trail, Morgan yeas 5 nays 5 and the motion was declared lost.

On motion of Russell seconded by Conger the Street Committee was instructed to notify Mr O. Shidler to clean the dirt from under the crossings, as per agreement.

Thence west along the first alley south of and parallel to Broadway to the Centre of Freedom Avenue.

For record that the City Engineer be authorized to contract with some reliable sewer builder to construct a lateral sewer commencing at a man hole at the intersection of Reed street and the first alley west of and parallel to North Webb Avenue thence east to the east side of Webb Avenue, and the property owners connecting to the same be required to give bond for the payment of their assessments, seconded by Miller the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, King, Loe, Miller, Russell, Scott, Seranton, Trail, Wilson, Morgan yeas 10 nays none and the motion was declared passed.

Sewer on East
Main street.

For record that the City Engineer be authorized to provide an outlet, so the property owners on the north side of East Main near Liberty Avenue can make connection with the Sanitary sewer seconded by Wilson and carried.

Pipe for 6th ward.

On motion of Wilson seconded by Seranton the Street Committee was authorized to purchase about 300 feet of 20 inch sewer pipe to build a storm water sewer in the 6th ward, commencing at State street and running north along the L. E. A. & S. R. R.

Sloan Alley

On motion of Conger seconded by Trail the Marshal was instructed to clear the alley in the rear of the James Sloan property in the first ward.

Resolution to
prohibit gambling
and slot machines.

Scranton offered the following resolution and moved its adoption: Be it resolved that the City Solicitor is hereby instructed to prepare an Ordinance curtailing and prohibiting the use or keeping of any and all slot machines and gambling devices in this City seconded by Wilson.

King moved to take the above resolution seconded by Conger and lost.

The above resolution was then voted upon and carried.

hire an assistant.

On motion of Trail seconded by King the City Engineer was authorized to hire an assistant to assist him while preparing plans for the sewers the City is about to build. On motion of Conger Council adjourned.
