

Alliance Ohio August 2nd 1897.

City Council met in regular session with president Morgan in the chair and the following members present Conger, Kay, King, Lorr, Miller, Russell, Scott, Scranton, Trail.

Mayors Report.

Minutes of the preceding meeting read and approved. Mayors report for the month of July 1897 was read showing fines and licenses collected during the month to the amount of Seven & $\frac{50}{100}$ Dollars, and on motion of Conger seconded by King the report was accepted.

Payment of Claims

Lorr stated that the Finance Committee had met and approved a number of Claims against the City and asked the Clerk to read the Bills, the Bills were read and Lorr moved that an Ordinance be prepared for their payment, the Ordinance being prepared was read, and Lorr moved that the Ordinance be placed on its passage seconded by King the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Kay, King, Lorr, Miller, Russell, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Morgan yeas 10 nays none and the Ordinance was declared passed.

Resolution to Construct Sanitary Sewers 9 and 32.

A. Resolution to improve certain streets and alleys by constructing Lateral Sewers No 9 and 32. Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance Ohio, that it is hereby declared necessary that the present sewer system be extended by excavating and laying sewer pipe according to plans, specifications and profile relating to the same now on file in the City Engineers Office along the following streets and alleys. Sewer No 32. Commencing at a manhole at the intersection of Mechanic Avenue with the first alley north of Main street; Thence west along the first alley north of and parallel to Main street to the west side of Park Avenue. Sewer No 9 Commencing at a manhole at the intersection of Mechanic Avenue and Prospect street, Thence west in Prospect street to Union Avenue, Thence south in Union Avenue to Main street. The cost and expense of said improvement shall be assessed per front foot upon the lots and lands abutting on said improvement according to the laws and Ordinances on the subject of assessments, and shall be payable in three annual installments, and bonds shall be issued in anticipation of the collection of such assessments.

The Clerk is hereby directed to cause this resolution to be published for two weeks in a newspaper published and of general circulation in the Corporation.

Lorr moved the adoption of the resolution seconded by Russell the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Kay, King, Lorr, Miller, Russell, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Morgan yeas 10 nays none and the resolution was declared adopted.

Engineers report on Reed St Sewer.

City Engineer Platts reported that he had received bids for the construction of the Sanitary sewer on Reed street, and Robert Learmonth being the lowest bidder was awarded the contract, and on motion of Conger seconded by Miller the report was accepted.

Ordinance to Construct Lateral Sewers No 19, 20, 21, 23, 26, 28 and 29.

An Ordinance to extend the present Sanitary sewer system by constructing Lateral sewers No 19, 20, 21, 23, 26, 28 and 29 was read and Lorr moved that the rules be suspended and the Ordinance read the second time by title seconded by Scranton the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Kay, King, Lorr, Miller, Russell, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Morgan yeas 10 nays none, the rules were declared suspended and the Ordinance was read the second time by title, and Lorr moved that the rules be again suspended and the Ordinance read the third time by title seconded by King the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Kay, King, Lorr, Miller, Russell, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Morgan, yeas 10 nays none, the rules were declared suspended and the Ordinance was read the third time by title, Lorr moved that the Ordinance be placed on its final passage seconded by King the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Kay, King, Lorr, Miller, Russell, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Morgan yeas 10 nays none and the Ordinance was declared passed.

P.F. & C. R. R. Co to connect to Sanitary sewer.

On motion of Conger seconded by Miller the P.F. & C. R. R. Co was granted permission to make an 8 inch connection to the Sanitary sewer.

Assessment of P.F. & C. R. R. Co

On motion of Kay seconded by Scranton the matter of assessing the P.F. & C. R. R. Co for Sanitary sewer was referred to the Solicitor, Civil Engineer and Sewer Committee.

Ordinance to assess Sewer No 24.

An Ordinance to assess a special tax for the construction of Sanitary sewer No 24 was read the first

A communication from the Chief of the Fire Dept asking for repairs and supplies for the department was read and on motion of Miller seconded by King the matter was referred to the fire committee.

Sidewalk Resolution
on Lot 782.

Miller offered the following resolution and moved its adoption: Be it Resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance, Ohio, that it is necessary, and that a sidewalk 6 feet wide, and of flag stone or brick shall be constructed along the west end of Lot No 782 to the established grade, and in accordance with the ordinances of this city. And the Mayor is hereby instructed to cause written notice to be served upon the owner of said premises of the passage of this resolution. Trail seconded the motion to adopt, the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Kay, King, Loe, Miller, Russell, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Morgan yeas 10 nays none and the
