

— Alliance Ohio September 20th 1897.

City Council met in regular session with Vice President Conger in the chair and the following members present Kay, King, Love, Miller, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Wilson.

Proposition from
R. J. B. Hazen.

Minutes of the preceding meeting read and approved. A communication from R. J. B. Hazen asking permission to erect a public Scale on the City Lot was read and on motion of Wilson seconded by Trail the matter was referred to the Com on Buildings & Grounds.

St Committee to
purchase Brick.

Wilson moved that the Street Committee be authorized to purchase two car load of Brick for Street Crossings, seconded by Miller the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Kay, King, Miller, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Wilson yeas 8 nays none and the motion was declared passed.

Alley north of
Christian Church.

On motion of Kay seconded by Scranton the condition of the Alley at the rear of the new Christian Church was referred to the Com on Streets and Alleys.

Repair approach
to Bridge.

Miller called the Councils attention to the dangerous condition of the north approach to the East Main St Bridge and moved that the same be repaired, the work to be done under the supervision of the City Civil Engineer, seconded by Trail the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Kay, King, Love, Miller, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Wilson yeas 9 nays none and the motion was declared passed.

Fence at Sewage
Disposal Works.

Scranton moved that the City Civil Engineer be authorized to have a fence built around the Sewage Disposal Works seconded by Wilson the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Kay, King, Miller, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Wilson nays Love. Yeas 8 nays 1 and the motion was declared passed.

Engineers Report
on Sewer Permits.

City Engineer O. W. Fouts made the following report to the Council. On September 14th 1897 I paid to the City Clerk, Sixty dollars, as money received for Sewer Permits issued during the first half of this year. this being the money received on Permits Nos 73 to 132 inclusive. On motion of Wilson seconded by Scott the above report was accepted.

Curfew Ordinance.

A. Curfew Ordinance was read the first time, and

Wilson moved that the rules be suspended and the Ordinance read the second time by title seconded by Love the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Kay, Love, Miller, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Wilson, nays Conger, King. yeas 7 nays 2 and the motion to suspend the rules was lost.

Election of
Police.

Mayor Truscott presented the name of John F. Matchett for Police for the unexpired term. Scott moved that the appointment of John F. Matchett be confirmed seconded by King the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Kay, King, Love, Miller, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Wilson yeas 9 nays none and the appointment of John F. Matchett was declared confirmed.

Repair City Prison
and Mayors Office.

On motion of King seconded by Scott the Building & Grounds Committee was authorized to make some necessary repairs in the City Prison and Mayors Office, the yeas and nays vote on the above motion resulted as follows yeas Conger, Kay, King, Love, Miller, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Wilson nays none.

Settlement with
J. M. Speaker.

On motion of Scott seconded by Wilson the matter of a settlement between J. M. Speaker and the City of Alliance, with reference to the City Engineers Office, was referred to the Com on Building and Grounds.

Passage of
Ordinance to
issue Refunding
Bonds.

An Ordinance to provide for the issuing of the Bonds of the City of Alliance, Ohio for the purpose of extending the time of payment of Refunding Bonds Nos. 952, 953, 954, 955, 956, 957, 958, 959 and 960 and the costs incident thereto, was read the first time, and Love moved that the rules be suspended and the Ordinance be read the second time by title seconded by Wilson the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Kay, King, Love, Miller, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Wilson yeas 9 nays none, the rules were declared suspended and the Ordinance was read the second time by title. Love moved that the rules be again suspended and the Ordinance read the third time by title seconded by King the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Kay, King, Love, Miller, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Wilson yeas 9 nays none, the rules were declared suspended and the Ordinance was read the third time by title. Love moved the Ordinance be placed on its final passage seconded by King the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Kay, King, Love,

Miller, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Wilson was 9 days

read the first time.

An Ordinance to license the owners of

property and the owners of hearses, was read the
first time.
