

Alliance Ohio October 2nd 1897.

A special meeting of the Alliance City Council was called in the City Hall Saturday evening October 2nd 1897 at 7 o'clock. This meeting was called for the purpose of considering the question of buying the Alliance Water Works.

Signed B. F. Truscott, Mayor.

President Morgan presided with the following members present, Conger, Kay, King, Love, Russell, Miller, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Williams, Wilson.

On motion of Wilson seconded by Trail the reading of the minutes of the preceding meeting was dispensed with.

City Engineer Fouts read a report to the Council giving the entire cost of the Alliance Water Works Plant.

City Solicitor Cramer read a Contract that he had prepared for the purchase of the Alliance ^{Water} Works Plant. The amount to be paid for the entire plant being \$198,000.

A Resolution to enter into a Contract for the purchase of the Alliance Water Works was read.

Kay moved that the above mentioned resolution be laid on the table for two weeks from next Monday night and that a citizens committee consisting of S. J. Williams, Morris Pennock, W. W. Webb, Wm Chambers, W. K. Fogg, E. E. Scranton, Frank Transue & Wm Stallecup be appointed to confer with the City Council with reference to the City buying the Alliance Water Works and make a report to the Council, seconded by Russell the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Kay, Love, Russell, Scranton, Wilson nays Conger, King, Scott, Trail, Williams, Morgan, Miller. yeas 5 nays 7 and the motion was declared lost.

On motion of Conger Council adjourned.
