

Aliance Ohio October 18th 1897.

Aliance City Council met in regular session with Vice President Conger presiding and the following members present Ray, King, Lorr, Miller, Russell, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Williams, Wilson.

Minutes of the preceding meeting read and Lorr moved that the minutes be corrected by adding to Mr Scranton's motion with reference to the Free fair that no gambling be allowed.

The minutes was then approved as corrected.

Morgan Engineering Co
granted permission to
erect Poles.

On motion of Wilson seconded by Williams the Morgan Engineering Co was granted permission to extend Electric Light Poles along Oxford street from Liberty Ave to Arch Avenue, so as to enable them to make connection with the Power house

Settlement with
Pennsylvania Co
to connect sewer.

Lorr of the sewer committee stated that the sewer committee had effected a settlement with the Pennsylvania R.R. Co, granting them permission to connect with the east side main sewer no 2 for the sum of two hundred & fifty dollars.

Lorr moved that the Clerk be authorized to issue a receipt to said Pennsylvania Co for two hundred and fifty dollars when said amount is paid, seconded by Wilson and carried.

Water Work com
granted extension of
time.

On motion of Trail seconded by Scranton the special Committee to whom was referred the feasibility and cost of the City erecting its own water plant, was granted an extension of time of two weeks, in which to complete its report.

Report from
Fire Com.

A report signed by the fire committee was presented and read recommending the purchase of two 25 foot ladders, a Police Patrol wagon and that one additional man be added to the fire department at a salary of forty five dollars (\$45.00) per month, also ten additional call men at one dollar per hour for the first hour and fifty cents per hour thereafter, and that rubber goods be furnished them. It will also be necessary to erect a small building on the south side of the present building to house this apparatus. The entire cost of the above mentioned improvements not to exceed \$1750.00 Miller moved that the above report be adopted seconded

by Williams and lost.

Ordinance to create
Office of Fire Engineer

An Ordinance to create the Office of Fire Engineer in the City of Alliance, Ohio, providing for his appointment and prescribing his duties was read. Loe moved that the above mentioned Ordinance be referred to the City Solicitor and Judiciary Committee seconded by Scott and carried.

Ordinance for
prevention of fires.

An Ordinance for the prevention of fires by the safe keeping of ashes and other combustible materials, and to protect fire apparatus in the City of Alliance, Ohio, was read.

Scranton moved that the above Ordinance be referred to the City Solicitor and Judiciary Committee seconded by Trail and carried.

Miss Birkett to
move Coal house.

On motion of Trail seconded by Scranton the Clerk was instructed to request Miss Birkett to move her coal house sufficiently, so as to permit Mr. Fetters to lay a sidewalk in the sixth ward along the east side of Miss ^{Birkett's lot.}

walk in front of
Baptist Church.

Loe called the Council's attention to a dangerous sidewalk in front of the Baptist Church, and moved that the same be referred to the sidewalk committee seconded by Russell and carried.

Curfew Ordinance.

The Curfew Ordinance was read the third time. Wilson moved that the Curfew Ordinance be placed on its final passage seconded by Scranton the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Kay, Loe, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Wilson nays Conger, King, Miller, Russell, Williams yeas 6, nays 5 and the final passage of the Ordinance was declared lost.

Officers to
enforce all City
Ordinances.

Russell moved that the Mayor, Marshal, Solicitor and Judiciary Committee make an effort to enforce all City Ordinances seconded by Scranton and carried.

Water Works Resolution.

Miller called for the reading of the Water Works resolution, and the resolution was read the second time.

Mayor Pressler was called upon for a speech, and he responded by making a few very appropriate remarks.

On motion of Miller seconded by Trail Council adjourned.
