The following communication was read.

To the City Council of the City of Alliance, Stark Co., Ohio
Gentlemen: The undersigned hereby request permission to construct and operate a Street Railway in the City of Alliance, Stark County, Ohio, in the following streets, to-wit: State Street between the west corporation line of said City and the east line of Union Ave., that is on said state street from the west corporation line of said City to the west terminus of the present City's Street Railway Co's line. The number of tracks to be one, together with necessary switches and turn-outs, and request your honorable body to take the necessary steps required by law, for establishing said route, and granting said permission.

On motion of Love, the foregoing communication was referred to the Judiciary Committee and City Solicitor.

The following resolution was read.

Resolved that the application of the Stark Electric Railway Co. be duly filed by the Clerk of the City and that

the Clerk be and hereby is authorized, empowred and instructed to publish a notice of the application of said, the Stark Electric Railway Co., for a franchise on state street from the west corporation line of said City to the east line of Union Ave., for 3 consecutive weeks in the Alliance Weekly Review as provided by law.

Scranton moved the adoption of the above resolution seconded by Trail the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Kay, King, Lov, Miller, Russell, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Williams, yeas 10 nays none and the resolution was declared adopted.

Lov of the finance Committee reported that the committee met and approved a number of Claims against the City and asked the Clerk to read the Ordinance for the payment of the Claims, the Ordinance was read, and Kay moved that the Ordinance be placed on its final passage seconded by Trail the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Kay, King, Lov, Miller, Russell, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Williams yeas 10 nays none and the Ordinance was declared passed.

On motion of Scott seconded by Lov, Mr Thomas Moore was granted permission to grade the first alley north of Grant and West of Mechanic streets, the work to be done under the supervision of the City Engineer and without cost to the City.

Russell moved that the City Engineer be instructed to make a survey and see whether or not the Pennsylvania Co's tracks are built on Prospect street just west of Freedom Avenue seconded by Scranton and carried.

Miller moved that the City Solicitor be instructed to take the Celestine Akins case to the Supreme Court seconded by Trail the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Kay, King, Lov, Miller, Russell, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Williams yeas 10 nays none and the motion was declared passed.

Kay moved that when this Council adjours it be to meet next Monday evening at the usual hour see by King and carried.

On motion of Lov seconded by Trail Council adjourned.
