

Alliance Ohio March 21st 1898.

The Alliance City Council met in regular session with Vice President Conger in the chair and the following members present Kay, King, Love, Miller, Russell, Scott, Scranton, Trail & Williams.

Minutes of the preceding meeting read and approved. A. damage bill from Mrs H. M. Marchand was read claiming damages to the amount of \$162.79 for changing grade at the corner of Freedom Avenue and Columbia street.

King moved that the claim of Mrs Marchand be referred to the Judiciary Committee seconded by Trail and carried.

On motion of Scott seconded by Love the Engineer was instructed to look after a crosswalk near David Pembroke's property on South Webb Avenue.

Scott moved that the City Engineer be authorized to purchase new Filter Cloths for the Disposal Works (the price to be 35^{cts} each.) seconded by Love the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Kay, King, Love, Miller, Russell, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Williams, yeas 10 nays none and the motion was declared passed.

On motion of Love seconded by Trail the Clerk was instructed to write Mr Runkle, President of the Alliance Water Works Co, and inform him of the fact that the City intend repairing Main Street in Alliance, from Arch Avenue to the C & P. R. R., and that the City Council would like to have the Water Co lay a new Water Main on the south side of Main Street the entire length of the improvement.

Love moved that the City Engineer prepare plans for Sanitary Sewer system in the sixth ward seconded by Scott and carried.

The City Clerk submitted his annual report to the Council for the year ending March 15th 1898. showing a balance on hand last statement \$19481.37
