

Alliance Ohio April 5th 1898.

The Alliance City Council met in regular session with President Morgan in the chair and the following members present, Conger, King, Miller, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Williams, Wilson.

Minutes of the preceding meeting read and approved. A. Communication from Mr W^m Runkle president of the Alliance Water Works Co was read with reference to laying a new Water Main on the south side of Main st and on motion of Conger seconded by Scott the communication was received and ordered placed on file.

The Printers affidavit of Publication of notice of application of the Stark Electric Railway Co to the Alliance City Council for permission to construct and operate a Street Railroad on State street in the City of Alliance, Stark Co, Ohio was presented and on motion of Scott seconded by Trail the same was received and ordered placed on file.

The Mayors report for the month of March showing Taxes collected to the amount of \$37⁰⁰ was read and on motion of Wilson seconded by Miller the report was accepted and ordered placed on file.

King of the Finance Committee reported that the committee had met and approved a number of claims against the City and asked the Clerk to read the Ordinance for their payment, the Ordinance was read and King moved that the Ordinance be placed on its passage seconded by Trail the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, King, Miller, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Williams, Wilson, Morgan yeas 9 nays none and the Ordinance was declared passed.

An Ordinance to establish a Street Railway route on State Street in the City of Alliance, Stark County, Ohio, to be known as route No 2, was read, and on motion of Wilson seconded by Conger the same was referred to the Judiciary Committee and City Solicitor.

King moved that when this Council adjourn it be to meet Monday evening April 11th 1898, at the usual hour in the Council Chamber seconded by Scott and carried.

City Civil Engineer Fouts submitted his annual Report to the Council and upon motion of Wilson seconded by Conger the report was accepted and ordered placed on file.

Ordinance to
Pave Main street.

An Ordinance to pave East Main Street with asphalt Block paving was read as follows:

Be it ordained and enacted by the Council of the City of Alliance, Stark County, Ohio:

Section 1.st That the improvement of Main Street in said City from the west line of the right-of-way of the Cleveland and Pittsburgh Railway Company to the west lot line of Arch Street be proceeded with in accordance with the resolution to improve the same adopted February 23rd 1898, by excavating, curbing, laying the proper foundation, and paving the same with asphalt block paving, and in otherwise improving as provided in said resolution.

Section 2. The cost and expense of said improvement shall be assessed per front foot upon the lots and lands abutting upon said proposed improvement, excepting such part of said cost and expense as the said City is by law required to pay, and said assessment shall be payable in five annual installments, and bonds of the City shall be issued in anticipation of the collection of such assessments.

Section 3.rd This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force when ten days shall have expired from and after its passage and legal publication.

Scott offered the following Resolution and moved its adoption: Be it resolved by this Council that the rule requiring that the Main street improvement Ordinance shall be fully and distinctly read on three different days be dispensed with, Conger seconded the motion to adopt the above resolution, the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, King, Miller, Scott, Seranton, Trail, Williams, Wilson, Morgan yeas 9 nays none and the resolution was declared adopted, Thereupon the Main street improvement Ordinance was read and Scott moved that the same be placed on its final passage seconded by Seranton the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, King, Miller, Scott, Seranton

Trail, Williams, Wilson, Morgan, yeas 9 nays none and the Ordinance was declared passed.

clerk to advertise for bids.

Trail moved that the City Clerk be instructed to advertise for bids for paving Main street with Asphalt Blocks, from the west right-of-way line of the C & P. R. R. and the west lot line of Arch street seconded by Conger the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, King, Miller, Scott, Scranton, Trail, Williams, Wilson, Morgan yeas 9 nays none and the motion was declared passed.

On motion of Wilson seconded by Trail Council adjourned.
