

Alliance Ohio April 18th 1898.

Organization of
Council.

This being the time for the organization of the Alliance City Council for the ensuing year, Mayor W. H. Dressler called the meeting to order.

The Roll was called with all members present.

W. W. Gilson from the 1st ward,
P. A. Gable " " 2nd ward,
W. H. Morgan " " 3rd ward,
S. Katzenstein " " 4th ward,
J. F. Zimmerman " " 5th ward, and
W. M. Scott " " 6th ward presented their certificates of

election, and Mayor Dressler administered to them the oath of office.

The Mayor stated that the first business in order would be to elect a President and President Protem for the ensuing year. Scott nominated W. H. Morgan for President, there being no further nominations on motion of King seconded by Scott the rules were suspended and Morgan was elected by acclamation.

Miller nominated O. C. Conger for President Protem, there being no further nominations, on motion of Wilson seconded by Miller the rules were suspended and Conger was elected by acclamation. Pres Morgan then took the chair.

King moved that the Rules that governed the old Council be adopted for the ensuing year seconded by Conger and carried.

Claim of
R. E. Jones.

A. Communication from R. E. Jones was read asking the City Council to compensate him to the amount of \$7.25 this being the amount it cost him to repair his sidewalk that was damaged on account of improper drainage on the part of the City. The Committee not being appointed for the ensuing year the matter was laid over for one week.

Mayor's Bond.

Mayor Dressler's Bond was presented to Council and Love moved that the Bond be accepted and placed on file seconded by Wilson the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Katzenstein, King, Love, Miller, Gilson, Scott, Zimmerman, Gable, Williams, Wilson, Morgan yeas 12 nays none the Mayor's Bond was declared accepted and ordered placed on file.

Treasurer's Bond.

City Treasurer W. P. Sharers Bond was presented to the Council and Love moved that the Bond be accepted and placed on file seconded by Conger the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Katzenstein, King, Love,

A. Petition to
pave Broadway.

Miller, Gilson, Scott, Zimmerman, Gable, Williams, Wilson, Morgan yeas 12. nays none and the Treasurer's Report was declared accepted and ordered placed on file.

In compliance with an Ordinance passed by the Alliance Council June 11th, 1873, to provide for the calling and empanneling Jurors by the Mayor, to sit in Criminal cases in Mayor's Court, a list of 144 names was read to the Council and on motion of Wilson seconded by King the list of names was accepted as read.

A Petition claiming to have the required number of signers to pave Broadway from Arch Ave to South Webb Avenue was presented to the Council and Love moved that the matter be referred to the City Engineer and Solicitor seconded by Scott and carried.

On motion of Love seconded by Conger the Engineer was instructed to prepare plans and specifications for the improvement of Broadway street from Arch Avenue to South Webb Avenue, and the City Solicitor to prepare a Resolution to improve the same.

King moved that when this Council adjourns it be to meet at the usual hour Monday evening April 26th, 1890 seconded by Scott and carried.

On motion of King seconded by Conger Council adjourns.
