City Council met in adjourned session with President Protem Conger in the chair and the following members present. Conger, Gilson, Gable, King, Katzenstein, Lorr, Miller, Scott, Williams absent Morgan, Wilson, Zimmerman.

Minutes of the preceding meeting read and approved.

Resolution to  
accept bid of  
Davis & Caldwell.

A. Resolution to accept bid and contract with Davis & Caldwell for the improvement of East Main Street was read as follows:

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance, Ohio, That the bid of Davis & Caldwell for the improvement of East Main Street in said City of Alliance, Ohio from the west line of the Cleveland & Pittsburgh Railroad Company's right of way to the west line of Arch Avenue be accepted, the same being the lowest bid, in the aggregate, for said work. And the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with said Davis & Caldwell with E. J. Davis, Henry Caldwell and C. H. Burchinal as their sureties for doing said work according to the plans and specifications therefore at the rates as contained in their said bid therefore now on file in the Office of the City Clerk.

Amount to be paid by the Corporation \$ 17097.50.

Ordinance to  
improve Broadway.

An Ordinance to Improve East Broadway Street from the East line of South Arch Avenue to the west line of South Dubb Avenue in the City of Alliance, Ohio, was read 1<sup>st</sup> time. Be it ordained and enacted by the Council of the City of Alliance Ohio as follows:-

Section 1. That the improvement of East Broadway street from the east line of South Arch Avenue to the West line of South Webb Avenue in the City of Alliance, Ohio be proceeded with in accordance with the resolution to improve the same adopted the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of May, A.D. 1898 by grading the same to the established grade, paving the roadway with bricks to a width of not less than thirty nine feet, setting curbs and gutters and constructing the necessary culverts, drains and retaining walls etc, in accordance with the plans, profiles and specifications now on file in the office of the City Civil Engineer.

Section 2. That the cost and expense of said improvement shall be assessed per front foot upon the lots and lands abutting upon said Street from South Arch Avenue to South Webb Avenue and said assessment shall be payable in five annual installments and bonds shall be issued in anticipation of the collection of such assessment.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law. Miller moved that the rules be suspended and the Ordinance read the second time seconded by King, the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Gilson, Gable, King, Katzenstein, Lovv, Miller, Scott, Williams yeas 9, nays none, the rules were declared suspended and the Ordinance was read the second time. Scott moved that the rules be again suspended and the Ordinance read the third time seconded by Williams the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Gilson, Gable, King, Katzenstein, Lovv, Miller, Scott, Williams, yeas 9 nays none the rules were declared suspended and the Ordinance was read the third time. Gable moved that the Ordinance be placed on its final passage seconded by Gilson, the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Gilson, Gable, King, Katzenstein, Lovv, Miller, Scott, Williams yeas 9 nays none and the Ordinance was declared passed.

B. H. Brosius and J. G. Tollerston as his  
sureties for doing said work according to plans and  
specifications therefor and at the rates provided for in  
his bids for said respective sewers.

Scott moved that the Water Committee be instructed to confer with the Alliance Water Works Co with reference to having new connections made along the East Main street improvement seconded by King and carried.

Gilson moved that the Light Committee be instructed to ascertain the cost of lighting the Mayors Office with Incandescent lights seconded by Miller and carried.

On motion of Scott seconded by Miller Council adjourned.
