

Alliance Ohio June 6th 1898.

The Alliance City Council met in regular session. President Morgan and President Protem Conger being absent the meeting was called to order by the Clerk and on motion of Scott seconded by King. Mr Gilson was elected President Protem.

The Roll was called with the following members present Gilson, King, Katzenstein, Lorr, Miller, Scott, Williams, ^{Wilson} Zimmerman, Absent Conger, Gable, & Morgan.

Mayor's Report.

Minutes of the preceding meeting read and approved. Mayor Pressler's ^{Monthly} report was read, showing fines and Licenses collected and turned over to the Clerk, amounting to Eighty eight & ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ Dollars, and Scott moved that the report be accepted and ordered placed on file seconded by Williams and carried.

Ordinance to issue Bonds for improvement of Broadway St.

An Ordinance for the issuing of Bonds of the City of Alliance, Ohio in anticipation of the collection of a special assessment on the property abutting on East Broadway Street from the east line of South Arch Avenue to the west line of South Webb Avenue in said City was read the first time as follows:

Section 1. Be it ordained and enacted by the Council of the City of Alliance, Ohio, That to pay the immediate cost and expense of improving East Broadway street from the east line of South Arch Avenue to the west line of South Webb Avenue in said City in accordance with an Ordinance passed June 1st A.D. 1898, and in anticipation of the collection of a special assessment therefor, the Mayor and Clerk of said City be and they are hereby authorized and directed to issue the bonds of the City in the sum of twelve thousand ^{dollars} as hereinafter provided.

Section 2. That said bonds shall consist of twenty bonds and shall be in denominations of six hundred dollars each and shall bear date of August 1st A.D. 1898, and shall become due and payable as follows:

Two thousand four hundred dollars in one year,
Two thousand four hundred dollars in two years,
Two thousand four hundred dollars in three years,
Two thousand four hundred dollars in four years, and
Two thousand four hundred dollars in five years from the

date of issue, as aforesaid.

Said bonds shall bear interest at the rate of five per centum per annum payable semi annually on the first day of February and on the first day of August of each year and the several installments of interest shall be evidenced by coupons attached to said bonds and both principal and interest shall be payable when due at the office of the City Treasurer of Alliance, Ohio.

Section 3. Said bonds shall be designated "East Broadway Street Improvement Bonds" and shall express on their face the purpose for which they are issued and that they are issued under and in pursuance of this Ordinance and they shall be signed by the Mayor and countersigned by the Clerk of said City under the corporate seal of said City and they shall be sold in the manner provided by law for the sale of municipal bonds.

Section 4. That upon sale of said bonds the proceeds thereof shall be placed in the treasury of said City to the credit of the "East Broadway Street Improvement Fund" and shall be applied to the payment of the cost and expense of improving said East Broadway Street and for no other purpose whatsoever; and the special assessments in anticipation of which said bonds are issued shall be paid into the said "East Broadway Street Improvement Fund" of said City when collected and shall be applied to the payment of the said bonds and the interest thereon as the same shall become due and to no other purpose whatsoever.

Provided that if on or before the sale of said bonds any of the property owners shall pay the full amount of their assessments less the interest included therein, the amount so paid shall be applied to the payment of the cost and expense of said improvement and bonds shall be issued for the unpaid remainder of the total amount to be provided.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period provided by law.

King moved that the rules be suspended and the Ordinance read the second time seconded by Miller the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gilson, King, Katzenstein, Lovv, Miller, Scott, Williams, ^{Wilson} Zimmerman,

yeas 9 nays none the rules were declared suspended and the Ordinance was read the second time. Scott moved that the rules be again suspended and the Ordinance read the third time seconded by Williams the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gilson, King, Katzenstein, Lovv, Miller, Scott, Williams, ^{Wilson} Zimmerman yeas 9 nays none, the rules were declared suspended and the Ordinance was read the third time. King moved that the Ordinance be placed on its final passage seconded by Katzenstein the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gilson, King, Katzenstein, Lovv, Miller, Scott, Williams, ^{Wilson} Zimmerman yeas 9 nays none and the Ordinance was declared passed.

Ordinance for
Payment of Claims.

An Ordinance for the payment of claims against the City of Alliance, Ohio was read and King moved that the Ordinance be placed on its passage seconded by Scott the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gilson, King, Katzenstein, Lovv, Miller, Scott, Williams, ^{Wilson} Zimmerman yeas 9 nays none and the Ordinance was declared passed as read.

Engineer to urge
work on Main st.

On motion of Scott seconded by Miller the City Civil Engineer was instructed to urge the Water and Gas Companies to proceed with their work on East Main street as rapidly as possible.

Stone Culvert
on West Main st.

King moved that the Bridge Committee be instructed to investigate the condition of the stone culvert on west Main street and confer with the County Commissioners with reference to repairing the same, seconded by Miller and carried.

Sidewalk on Ely st.

On motion of Lovv, seconded by Wilson the repairing of the sidewalk on Ely Street next to the Bridge was referred to the sidewalk Committee with power to act.

Clark to advertise.

On motion of Scott seconded by Williams the City Clerk was instructed to advertise for bids for the improvement of Broadway street and also for the sale of Broadway street improvement bonds as soon as the Ordinances with reference to the improvement have been published the required length of time.

Solicitor to Prepare
Ordinance.

Lovv moved that the Solicitor be instructed to prepare an Ordinance regulating the moving of buildings in the City of Alliance, Ohio seconded by Zimmerman & carried.

Solicitor to prepare Ordinance.

Miller moved that the City Solicitor be instructed to prepare an Ordinance regulating the riding of Bicycles upon the streets and sidewalks of Alliance, Ohio, seconded by Katgenstein and carried.

On motion of King seconded by Miller Council adjourned.
