

Alliance Ohio July 11th 1898.
 The Alliance City Council met in special session in the City Hall upon the following call.

A special meeting of the Alliance City Council will be held in the City Hall at the usual hour Monday evening July 11th 1898, for the purpose of passing the Claim Ordinance, and electing an Engineer for the Sewage Disposal Works.

President Morgan and President Protem Conger being absent at the time for Council to open the meeting was called to order by the Clerk Katgenstein moved that Mr Wilson be elected President Protem seconded by Lovr and carried. The Roll was called with the following members present Gilson, Gabel, King, Katgenstein, Lovr, Miller, Scott, Williams, Wilson, Zimmerman
 Absent Conger & Morgan. ^{Reading of minutes of preceding meeting was dispensed with.} (Conger came in later.)

King called for the reading of the Claim Ordinance, the Ordinance was read and King moved that the same be placed on its passage seconded by Scott the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Gilson, Gabel, King, Katgenstein, Lovr, Miller, Scott, Williams, Wilson, Zimmerman yeas 11 nays none and the Ordinance was declared passed.

Claim Ordinance

Applicant for
 Engineer at Sewer

The Clerk announced the names of J. A. Matticks, J. M. English & W. H. Hughes as applicants for the position of Engineer at the Sewage Disposal Works. King moved that the Engineer at the Sewage Disposal Works be elected to serve until the first day of April 1899 seconded by Scott and carried. Chairman Wilson appointed King and Scott to act as tellers and prepare slips of paper for each Councilman, and proceeded to ballot for Engineer at Disposal Works. A Ballot was taken and King announced the result as follows, J. A. Matticks

and J. M. English 4, thereupon J. A. Matticks was declared elected Engineer at the Sewage Disposal Works until the 1st day of April 1899.

King moved that Council adjourn seconded by Miller and carried.
