

Alliance Ohio July 18th 1898.

The Alliance City Council met in regular session with President Morgan in the chair and the following members present, Conger, Gilson, Gable, King, Katzenstein, Love, Miller, Scott, Williams, Wilson, Zimmerman

Mayors Report

Minutes of the preceding meeting read and approved Mayor Dressler report for the month of June 1898, was read showing Fines and Licenses collected to the amount of \$65.~~00~~ and on motion of Love seconded by Gilson the report was accepted and ordered placed on file.

J. K. Allen Report.

J. K. Allen Secretary of the Alliance Cemetery Directors submitted his report to Council for the six months ending June 30th 1898 as follows:

On motion of Wilson seconded by Williams the above report of Secretary Allen was accepted and ordered placed on file.

Bond Sale

King of the Finance Committee reported to the Council that the City Savings Bank of Alliance, was the highest bidder on the \$9600 East Broadway street Improvement Bonds their bid being par and a premium of \$276.⁰⁰.

Wilson moved that the bid of the City Savings Bank of Alliance be accepted and the bonds be awarded to them, seconded by Scott the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Gable, King, Katzenstein, Love, Miller, Scott, Williams, Wilson, Zimmerman, Morgan yeas 11 nays none and the \$9600 East Broadway street Improvement Bonds were declared awarded to the City Savings Bank of Alliance, Ohio.

Broadway Bids

Scott moved that the bids received for the improvement of East Broadway st be referred to the Street Committee, President of Council, City Civil Engineer and the property owners on Broadway, and report to Council on the same at the next meeting seconded by Williams and carried.

Noble Street.

Miller moved that the Street Commissioner be instructed to perform the necessary work on Noble St near the M. L. Phillis property seconded by Gable and carried.

Sidewalk on
North Freedom Ave.

Gilson moved that the condition of the sidewalk on the west side of Freedom Ave between Market and Columbia streets be referred to the Sidewalk Com, Civil Engineer and Solicitor and make a report to the Council on the same seconded by Scott and carried.

Painting East
Main St Viaduct.

Love of the Bridge Committee reported that he had received one bid to put two coats of paint upon the East Main St Viaduct, after first scraping the same for \$243⁰⁰.

Scott moved that the painting of the East Main Street Viaduct be left in the hands of the Bridge Committee with power to act seconded by Wilson and carried.

Swan on Arch
and Union Avenues.

Congru called the Councils attention to the condition of the Storm Swan on Arch Ave, north of P.F.W. & C.R.R. and also the Storm Swan on Union Ave near the P.F.W. & C.R.R. and moved that the same be referred to the Street Commissioner with power to act seconded by Wilson and carried.

Stone Crusher.

Hon S. J. Williams presented to the City Council the grievance of the residents near the City Lot where the stone crusher is located, and asked them to take some action to try and have something done to prevent so much dust and smoke.

Love moved that the matter referred to by Mr Williams be referred to the City Engineer to confer with the Contractor and have the wishes of the people carried out seconded by Wilson and carried.

City of Alliance
paid for \$500.

Mayor Dussler stated to the Council that the City of Alliance and James W. Clark & wife have been sued jointly for five hundred dollars by Mrs Anna Taylor and Wilson moved that the City Solicitor be instructed to take charge of the case in behalf of the City seconded by Gilson and carried.

Police to report
on St Lights

On motion of Gable seconded by Miller the City Clerk was instructed to notify the Police to keep a strict account of all Street Lights not burning properly, and make a report of the same to the Clerk each month.

Paint City Buildings.

Wilson of the Building and Grounds Committee reported

that he had received a bid to paint the City Hall Fire Department Buildings and City Prison with two coats of paint for \$8500.

Katzenstein moved that the Buildings and Grounds Committee be instructed to have the Buildings above mentioned painted at the price named seconded by Gable and carried.

On motion of Gable seconded by Scott the Clerk was instructed to notify Jno C. Cook and R. S. Kaylor to remove all obstruction off Liberty corner between Main street and the P. F. W. & C. R. R.

The following report was read to the Council Gentlemen:-

We, the undersigned, members of the Printing Committee of the City Council, hereby recommend that the legal advertising for the City of Alliance for the coming year be given to the Alliance Daily Review at 60% of the legal rate and that it also be placed in the Alliance Daily Leader at 30% of the legal rates.

A. Petition from the property owners on Washington Ave was read to the Council asking to have the water pipes extended along said street and on motion of Love seconded by King the matter was referred to the Water Com.

Scott moved that when this Council adjourns it be to meet Thursday evening July 21st 1898 at the usual hour seconded by King and carried.

An Ordinance regulating the use of Bicycles, Tricycles and Tandems on the Streets and sidewalks of the City of Alliance was read the first time.

On motion of Miller seconded by King Council adjourned.
