

Ulliance Ohio August 15th, 1898.

Ulliance City Council met in regular session with President pro tem Conger in the chair and the following members present King, Katzenstein, Loe, Miller, Scott, Wilson, Zimmerman, absent Gilson, Gable, Williams and Morgan.

Minutes of the preceding meeting read and approved.

Petition against
Paving North
Union Avenue.

A Petition signed by property owners on North Union Avenue protesting against the paving of Union Avenue from Main Street to Ely Street was read and on motion of Loe seconded by Miller the same was referred to the Judiciary Committee.

Communication
asking for repairs

A Communication from the property owners on North Union Avenue was read, asking the Council to instruct the Street Commissioner to make some necessary repairs near the intersection of Union Ave and Erie Street and on motion of Miller seconded by Wilson the matter was referred to the Street Committee.

Petition to
extend Water Main

A Petition signed by property owners in the sixth ward was read to the Council, asking them to have the water main extended a distance of 825 feet for the protection of the College property, in case of fire, and on motion of Katzenstein seconded by Scott the matter was referred to the Water Committee to report on the same at the next meeting.

Mrs H. M. Marchand
and Mrs Orr sidewalk.

Katzenstein moved that Mrs H. M. Marchand be granted permission to lay a sidewalk along the south end of lots No 714 and 715 so the same will conform with Mrs Orr's walk along the south end of lot No 716, seconded by Loe and carried.

Proposal to construct
Stark Electric Rail
road.

A proposition for the construction and operation of the Stark Electric Railroad was presented to the Council and on motion of King seconded by Miller the same was laid on the table until the next meeting.

Payment of Claim

King of the finance Committee reported that the committee had met and approved a claim against the City and asked the Clerk to read the Ordinance for the payment of the same. The Ordinance was read and King moved that it be placed on its passage seconded by Scott the yeas and nays were called.

resulting yeas Conger, King, Katzenstein, Lorr, Miller, Scott, Wilson, Zimmerman yeas 8 nays none and the Ordinance was declared passed.

Scott moved that the Clerk be instructed to notify the Electric Light Co to move one of their poles that stands out in the alley east of Arch Avenue near the residence of Joseph Lamont seconded by King and carried.

Wilson moved that the Street Commissioner be instructed to lay a 6 inch tile drain on the east side of Union Avenue near the Dustman property, the property owners to furnish the tile, seconded by Katzenstein and carried.

Miller moved that the Clerk be instructed to order five car loads of slag, the same to be used for repairing Macadamized streets, seconded by Wilson the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, King, Katzenstein, Lorr, Miller, Scott, Wilson, Zimmerman yeas 8 nays none and the motion was declared passed.
