

Alliance Ohio Sept 19th 1898.

Alliance City Council met in regular session in the City Hall with President Morgan in the chair and the following members present Conger, Gilson, Gabler, King, Katzenstein, Love, Miller, Scott, Zimmerman. absent Williams & Wilson.

Minutes of the preceding meeting read and approved. A communication from Wright & Pennock was read to the Council, with reference to the condition of the hitching posts on the east side of the Public Square and on motion of Conger seconded by Gilson the matter was referred to the Street Committee with power to act.

King of the finance committee moved that the Clerk be instructed to notify the Board of Health that the Sanitary fund providing for the payment of the Sanitary Police would be exhausted by the end of the present month, seconded by Conger and carried.

On motion of Zimmerman seconded by Scott the opening of an Alley east of Union Ave and south of Cambridge st was referred to the Platting Committee. Scott moved that the City Civil Engineer be instructed to notify the Contractors of the East Main Street Improvement to finish their work on the improvement according to specifications seconded by Gilson and carried.

On motion of Scott seconded by Conger the City Civil Engineer was instructed to survey the first Alley west of and parallel with Mechanic Avenue from Main Street to the P. F. W. & C. R. R. to determine the proper lines of said Alley.

King stated that the Engineer had prepared a grade Ordinance on Millner Street and moved that the same be referred to the Committee on grades seconded by Conger and carried.

King moved that the matter of hauling dirt off Broadway to South Webb Ave and to the Mrs Davis lot be referred to the Committee on Streets and Alleys seconded by Scott and carried.

Katzenstein moved that the matter of cleaning up the City lot be referred to the City Engineer see by Conger and carried.

Propositions from the Chicago Fire Hose Co and the Burke Hose Co was read to Council giving prices and terms for furnishing the City with Fire hose and Miller moved that the matter of purchasing hose be referred to the Fire Committee with power to act seconded by Conger the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Gilson, Gable, King, Katzenstein, Lov, Miller, Scott, Zimmerman, Morgan yeas 10 nays none and the motion was declared passed.

Fix Railing on
Sidewalk on north
Freedom Ave.

On motion of Katzenstein seconded by Miller the Committee on Streets and Alleys was instructed to repair the railing along the sidewalk over the run near the Dutton property on North Freedom Avenue.

Ditch at Rear
of Fauble

On motion of Gable seconded by Conger a ditch at the rear of Henry Fauble's property on Arch Ave was referred to the Committee on Streets and Alleys to make a report of the same at the next regular meeting.

to lay walks.

Lov moved that the Sidewalk Committee be instructed to lay sidewalks that have been legally ordered laid and the parties refused to comply with the orders seconded by Gilson and carried.

Club to notify
Property owners to repair
walks.

On motion of Miller the Club was instructed to notify property owners on North Webb Ave to repair walks.

Resolutions.

Katzenstein offered the following resolution and moved the adoption of the same. Be it Resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance, Ohio, that it is necessary and that a sidewalk 6 feet wide, and of flag stone or brick shall be constructed along the south end of lot No 2721 to the established grade, and in accordance with the Ordinances of this City. And the Mayor is hereby instructed to cause written notice to be served upon the owner of said premises of the passage of this resolution. Lov seconded the motion to adopt the foregoing resolution.

Public gatherings.

An Ordinance to Protect public gatherings in Theaters and other places of amusement and entertainment was read the second time.

Ordinance to protect
East Main st.

An Ordinance to Protect East Main street from injury by horses, mules and other animals was read the second time.

Ordinance to
establish grade
on North Union
Avenue.

An Ordinance to establish the grade on North Union Avenue from the north line of Main street to the south line of Ely street was read the first time as follows: Be it ordained and enacted by the Council of the City of Alliance, Ohio, as follows:

Section 1st: That the grade of North Union Avenue from the north line of Main Street to the south line of Ely street be and the same is hereby established as follows; to wit: Commencing at the north curb line of Main street and at the east curb line of north Union Avenue at an elevation of 107.10 feet above the established datum; thence along the top of said east curb of said north Union Avenue descending regularly for a distance of 291 feet north to the south curb line of east Prospect street to an elevation of 92.60 feet above said datum; thence north along the top of said east curb of north Union Avenue descending regularly for a distance of 28 feet to the north line of said East Prospect street to an elevation of 91.36 feet above said datum; thence north along the top of said east curb of north Union Avenue descending regularly for a distance of 149 feet to the north line of a fifteen foot Alley to an elevation of 78.00 feet above said datum; thence north along the top of said east curb of north Union Avenue descending regularly for a distance of 232 feet to the center of a twenty foot alley to an elevation of 76.84 feet above said datum; thence north along the top of said east curb of north Union Avenue ascending regularly for a distance of 170 feet to the south curb line of East Ely street to an elevation of 79.25 feet above said datum. And that the west curb line of said north Union Avenue shall conform to the various

elevations of said east curb line of said street except as it may be necessary to vary the same to meet existing intersections as heretofore graded.

Section 2. That any and all grades heretofore established for said north Union Avenue between the points named in section 1st hereof be and the same hereby are repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and legal publication.

Congru moved that the rules be suspended and the Ordinance read the second time seconded by Gable the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Congru, Gilson, Gable, King, Katzenstein, Lovv, Miller, Scott, Zimmerman, Morgan yeas 10 nays none the rules were declared suspended and the Ordinance was read the second time, Congru moved that the rules be again suspended and the Ordinance read the third time seconded by Miller the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Congru, Gilson, Gable, King, Katzenstein, Lovv, Miller, Scott, Zimmerman, Morgan yeas 10 nays none the rules were declared suspended and the Ordinance was read the third time. Congru moved that the Ordinance be placed on its final passage seconded by Scott the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Congru, Gilson, Gable, King, Katzenstein, Lovv, Miller, Scott, Zimmerman, Morgan yeas 10 nays none and the Ordinance was declared passed.

Ordinance to
improve north
Union Avenue

An Ordinance to improve North Union Avenue from the north line of Main Street to the south line of Ely Street was read the first time as follows:

Be it ordained and enacted by the Council of the City of Alliance, Ohio, as follows:-

Section 1st That the improvement of North Union Avenue from the north line of Main Street to the south line of Ely Street in the City of Alliance, Ohio, be proceeded with in accordance with the Resolution to improve the same adopted on the 1st day of August, A.D. 1898 by grading the same to the grade as established by an Ordinance passed concurrently herewith, paving the roadway with bricks or blocks to a width of not less than 34 feet, setting curbs and gutters and constructing the necessary culverts, drains and retaining walls etc.

in accordance with the plans, profiles and specifications now on file in the office of the City Civil Engineer.

Section 2. That the cost and expense of said improvement shall be assessed per front foot upon the lots and lands abutting upon said improvement and said assessments shall be payable in seven annual installments and bonds shall be issued in anticipation of the collection of such assessment.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and legal Publication.

Miller moved that the rules be suspended and the foregoing Ordinance be read the second time seconded by Scott the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Gilson, Gable, King, Katznstein, Lov, Miller, Scott, Zimmerman, Morgan yeas 10 nays none the rules were declared suspended and the Ordinance was read the second time. Gable moved that the rules be again suspended and the Ordinance read the third time seconded by Miller the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Gilson, Gable, King, Katznstein, Lov, Miller, Scott, Zimmerman, Morgan yeas 10 nays none the rules were declared suspended and the Ordinance was read the third time. Conger moved that the Ordinance be placed on its final passage seconded by Gable the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Gilson, Gable, King, Katznstein, Lov, Miller, Scott, Zimmerman, Morgan yeas 10 nays none and the Ordinance was declared passed.

Storm Sewer on
North Union Ave.

On motion of Scott seconded by Miller the Sewer on Union Avenue under the P. F. W. & C. R. R. was referred to the City Engineer and Sewer Committee.

Stark Electric
Railway Ordinance

On motion of Conger seconded by King the Stark Electric St Railway Ordinance was laid on the table.
