

Alliance Ohio November 22nd 1898.

Special Session.

The Alliance City Council met in special session upon the following call.

A special meeting of the Alliance City Council will be held at 7 O'clock Tuesday evening November 22nd 1898, in the City Hall. This meeting is called for the purpose of transacting the following business:-

To pass on matters relative to the East Main St Improvement.

To pass on matters relative to the City of Alliance purchasing the water works plant from the Alliance Water Works Company.

To pass an Ordinance for the payment of Claims.

To pass an Ordinance to assess a special tax for the construction of Lateral Sanitary Sewers Nos 9, 19, 20, 21, 23, 26, 28, 29 and 32.

To pass an Ordinance to issue bonds of the City of Alliance, Ohio, in the sum of Eighty one thousand dollars for the purpose of paying a portion of the purchase price of the water works plant of the Alliance Water Works Company and to consider the matter of laying a larger water pipe into the City building.

The meeting was called to order by President W. H. Morgan with the following members present, Gilson, Gable, King, Katzenstein, Miller, Scott, Williams, Wilson, Absent Conger, Love, Zimmerman. Present 9, Absent 3.

The minutes of the preceding meeting was read and approved.

Scott moved that the East Main Street Improvement from Arch Avenue to the Cleveland & Pittsburgh Railroad be accepted by the Council seconded by Williams, the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gilson, Gable, King, Katzenstein, Miller, Scott, Williams, Wilson, Morgan yeas 9 nays none and the motion was declared passed.

King moved that \$147.13 be deducted from the final Estimate of Davis & Caldwell for the Improvement of East Main Street, said amount to cover the claims of J. T. Tullis, C. E. Hudson, Her Machine Works and the estimated amount to replace broken flag stone along the improvement, seconded by Wilson, the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gilson, Gable, King, Katzenstein

Ordinance to
pay claim.

An Ordinance to pay Davis & Caldwell \$3855.16 was read to the Council and King moved that the Ordinance be placed on its passage seconded by Scott the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gilson, Gable, King, Katzenstein, Miller, Scott, Williams, Wilson, Morgan yeas 9 nays none and the Ordinance was declared passed.

Mayors Report
to Council.

The following report was presented and read to the Council.
To the Honorable City Council,

Clerks Report
to Council.

The following report was presented and read to the Council.
To the Honorable City Council,

Alliance, Ohio.

Gentlemen: I have to submit to your honorable body, that in accordance with law and within the time prescribed therefor the Hon. W. H. Dressler, Mayor of Alliance, and the undersigned J. H. McConnell, Clerk of said City met and made a canvas of the votes cast at the election held November 8th 1898, on the question of ratifying the contract between the City of Alliance, Ohio and the Alliance Water Works Co and we then and there ascertained and declared said vote to be as follows,

The total number of votes cast at the election in the City of Alliance was 2124. The number of votes cast for the ratification of the contract for the purchase

of the Alliance Water Works Plant was 1249, and the number cast against the purchase of the Alliance Water Works Plant was 669, making a majority of 187 votes over all the votes cast at the election, in favor of the ratification of the contract for the purchase of the Alliance Water Works Plant.

An Ordinance to assess a special tax for the construction of Lateral Sanitary Sewers Nos 9, 19, 20, 21, 23, 26, 28, 29 and 32 was read the first time and Wilson moved that the rules be suspended and the Ordinance read the second time seconded by Gable the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gilson, Gable, King, Katzenstein, Miller, Scott, Williams, Wilson, Morgan yeas 9 nays none, the rules were declared suspended and the Ordinance was read the second time, and Miller moved that the rules be again suspended and the Ordinance read the third time seconded by Williams the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gilson, Gable, King, Katzenstein, Miller, Scott, Williams, Wilson, Morgan yeas 9 nays none, the rules were declared suspended and the Ordinance was read the third time, and Scott moved that the Ordinance be placed on its final passage seconded by Miller the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gilson, Gable, King, Katzenstein, Miller, Scott, Williams, Wilson, Morgan yeas 9 nays none and the Ordinance was declared passed.

Water Pipe into City Building.

Gilson moved that the matter of laying a larger water pipe into the City Building be referred to the Water Committee and City Civil Engineer with power to act seconded by
