

Alliance Ohio December 5th 1898.

The Alliance City Council met in regular session in the City Hall. President Morgan and President pro tem Conger being absent the meeting was called to order by the Clerk.

Wilson moved that Mr Love act as president pro tem of the meeting seconded by Gilson and carried.

Mr Love took the chair, and the roll was called with the following members present Gilson, Gabel, King, Love, Scott, Wilson, Zimmerman. Absent Conger, Katzenstein, Miller, Williams, Morgan. Present 7 absent 5.

The minutes of the preceding meeting was read and approved.

Mayors Reports.

Mayor Dresslers reports for the months of October and November 1898 was read to the Council showing Fines and Licenses collected in October amounting to \$101.00 and Fines collected in November amounting to \$42.00.

On motion of Wilson seconded by Scott the Mayors reports was accepted and ordered placed on file.

Estimate on
Broadway Impt.

King moved that \$270.00 be deducted from Estimate No 2. of John Daffy, on the East Broadway Improvement as liquidated damages, seconded by Scott the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gabel, King, Scott. nays Love, Wilson, Zimmerman yeas 3 nays 3 and the motion was declared lost. (Mr Wilson failed to vote on foregoing motion)

Claims Ordinances.

An Ordinance for the payment of Claims was read and King moved that the ordinance be placed on its passage seconded by Scott the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gilson, Gabel, King, Love, Scott, Wilson, Zimmerman, yeas 7. nays none and the Ordinance was declared passed.

Engineer to set
stakes in 6th ward.

Scott moved that the City Civil Engineer be instructed to set stakes to locate north line of first alley north of the 6th ward seconded by King and carried. ^{Mr. Robinsons, property}

St. Commissioner
to repair walk on
Rosenberry St.

On motion of Scott, ^{seconded by King} the Street Commissioner was instructed to repair the sidewalk over the run on Rosenberry street, west of the O. R. & L. & R. R.

Crossing on Park Ave.

On motion of Zimmerman seconded by Wilson the Street Committee was instructed to repair a crossing at the intersection of Park Ave and Columbia Street.

Repairs at
Sewage Dispo.

Gilson moved that the Sewer Committee be instructed to purchase a new Lime tank, new filter cloths and make some other repairs necessary at the Sewage Disposal Works, seconded by Wilson the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gilson, Gable, King, Love, Scott, Wilson, Zimmerman, yeas 7 nays none and the motion was declared passed.

Marshal to have
cellar drain fixed.

Wilson moved that the City Marshall be authorized to employ a man to repair the drain to the Cellar under the City Hall, said work to be done under the supervision of the City Engineer, seconded by Gilson and carried.

Scott moved that when this Council adjourns it be to meet Monday evening December 12th 1898 at the usual hour, seconded by Gable and carried.

On motion of Gilson seconded by Gable Council adjourned.
