Engineers Report.

City Engineer submitted plans and specifications for the improvement of South Webb Ave between Ash Street and Cambridge street.

North Union Ave.

Gilson moved that the Street Committee be instructed to bring the matter of improving North Union Ave before the Council, so the work can be started as early as possible in the spring, seconded by Zimmerman and carried.

Drainage near Stearns Property.

On motion of Love seconded by Williams the street Committee was instructed to look after the drainage near the Mrs Stearns property on Market street.

Communication from Chief of Fire Dept.

A. Communication from the Fire Chief and Fire Committee was presented and read to Council.

Fire Inspector

Love moved that the Fire Committee be instructed to prepare an estimate of the purchase price of the Fire Department and report the same to Council at the next meeting seconded by Scott and carried.

On motion of Scott, <sup>seconded by King</sup> the Fire Committee was instructed to examine the Ordinances with reference to fire inspectors and if necessary recommend an Ordinance to establish such an officer

Finance Com to purchase Books.

Miller moved that the Finance Committee be instructed to purchase three volumes of Ohio Statutes and fifteen volumes of Councilmen's Manuals seconded by Zimmerman and carried.

Ordinance to establish Water Trusts.

An Ordinance to establish a board of Trustees of the Water Works in and for the City of Alliance, Ohio, was read to Council for the first time, and King moved that the rules be suspended and the Ordinance

be read the second time seconded by Gable, the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gilson, Gable, King, Katzenstein, Lovv, Miller, Scott, Williams, Zimmerman, Morgan, yeas 10 nays none, the rules were declared suspended and the Ordinance was read the second time. Miller moved that the rules be again suspended and the Ordinance be read the third time seconded by Scott the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gilson, Gable, King, Katzenstein, Lovv, Miller, Scott, Williams, Zimmerman, Morgan, yeas 10 nays none, the rules were declared suspended and the Ordinance was read the third time, King moved that the Ordinance be placed on its final passage seconded by Scott, the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gilson, Gable, King, Katzenstein, Lovv, Miller, Scott, Williams, Zimmerman, Morgan, yeas 10 nays none and the Ordinance was declared passed.

Ordinance to regulate rendering of Lard etc.

An Ordinance to regulate the rendering and melting of Lard, tallow, fat and other grease so as to insure safety from fire was read the first time.

King moved that when this Council adjourns it be to meet next Monday evening February 13<sup>th</sup> 1899 at the usual hour seconded by Scott and carried. On motion of Scott seconded by Gilson Council adjourns.
