

City Council O. March 6th 1899.

The Alliance City Council met in regular session in the City Hall, president Morgan and president pro tem Conger being absent the meeting was called to order by the City Clerk.

On motion of King seconded by Williams Mr Love was elected president pro tem of the meeting. The Roll was called with the following members present Gilson, King, Love, Miller, Scott, Williams, Wilson, Gimmurman Absent Conger, Gable, Morgan. The Minutes of the two preceding meetings was read and approved.

At this time Mr O. C. Conger came into Council Chamber.

An Ordinance for the payment of Claims was presented and read and King moved that the Ordinance be placed on its passage seconded by Scott the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Gilson, King, Love, Miller, Scott, Williams, Wilson, Gimmurman yeas 9 nays none and the Ordinance was declared passed.

Mayor Dressler's report for the month of February 1899, showing fines collected during the month to the amount of \$53⁰⁰ was read to Council and on motion of Conger seconded by Wilson the report was accepted and ordered placed on file.

City Engineer Pouts presented and read his specifications for the Improvement of South Union Ave from Main Street to Grant Street.

Scott moved that where ^{South} matters were referred to the City Civil Engineer in the Union Ave specifications, that the Street Committee be included seconded by Wilson and carried.

Gilson moved that where the quantities of materials used in Asphalt Block appeared in the south Union Ave specifications, that the same be stricken out, and that each firm be required to specify the ingredients in samples presented seconded by Gimmurman and carried. Scott moved that the specifications for the improvement of South Union Avenue from Main Street to Grant Street be adopted as amended seconded by King the yeas and nays were called resulting

At Commission
to place Danger Light.

On motion of Conger seconded by Wilson the Street Commissioner was instructed to place a light on a wagon that was broken down and standing in the street near the intersection of North Union Avenue and Ely Street.

Grade North
Liberty Ave.

Miller moved that the City Engineer be instructed to make an estimate of the cost of grading North Liberty Avenue and report the same to Council seconded by King and carried.

Clerk to have
notices printed

On motion of Zimmerman seconded by King the City Clerk was instructed to have some notices printed forbidding the dumping of refuse matter within the City limits, and have the Marshal post the same at various places.

Sanitary Sewers.

Gilson moved that the matter of building some new Lateral Sanitary Sewers be referred to the Sewer Committee ^{and Engineer} seconded by Miller and carried.

North Webb Ave
Storm Sewer.

Miller moved that the Storm Sewer near Chris Cooper's property on North Webb Avenue be referred to the Committee on Sewers to report on the same at the next regular meeting seconded by Scott and carried.

Catch Basin.

On motion of King seconded by Zimmerman the Catch Basin at the intersection of Market Street and Park Avenue was referred to the Sewer Committee and Civil Engineer.

Fire Department
Ordinance.

Gilson moved that the Fire Committee and City Solicitor be instructed to prepare an Ordinance governing the Fire Department and submit the same to Council seconded by Miller and carried.

Engineers reported
dangerous Sidewalk.

City Engineer Fouts reported a dangerous sidewalk on North Freedom Avenue and on motion of Scott seconded by Williams the same was ordered thrown out by the Street Commissioner.

Resolution to
improve South
Union Ave.

A Resolution to improve South Union Avenue from the South line of Main Street to the South line of Grant Street in the City of Alliance, Ohio. was read to Council as follows:

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of

Alliance, Ohio; That it is necessary to improve South Union Avenue from the South line of Main street to the South line of Grant Street by grading the same to the established grade, paving the roadway with Asphalt Block to a width of not less than thirty four feet, setting curbs and gutters and constructing the necessary culverts, drains and retaining walls etc. etc., in accordance with the plans, profiles and specifications on file in the office of the City Civil Engineer; the cost and expense of said improvement shall be paid by an assessment assessed per front foot upon the lands and lots abutting upon said improvement between the points above named; said assessment shall be payable in five annual installments and bonds shall be issued in anticipation of the collection of such assessment.

And the Clerk of said City is hereby directed to cause this resolution to be published for two weeks in a newspaper published and of general circulation in the corporation and Dennis Smeltz, the City Marshal, is hereby appointed to serve notice of the passage of this resolution upon the owners of property abutting upon said improvement who are residents of Stark County, Ohio.

Scott moved that the foregoing resolution be adopted as read seconded by King the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Conger, Gilson, King, Love, Miller, Scott, Williams, Wilson, Zimmerman, yeas 9, nays none and the resolution was declared adopted.

On motion of Conger seconded by King Council adjourned
