

Special Meeting

Alliance O. July 6th, 1899.
The Alliance City Council met in Special session upon the following Call;

You are hereby notified that a special meeting of the Council, of the City of Alliance, Ohio, will be held in the City Hall, of the said City, on Thursday evening, July 6th, 1899 at 7-30 o'clock. This meeting is called for the purpose of transacting the following business to wit;-- To pass an Ordinance for the payment of Claims; To award contract for the construction of sidewalks; and to transact other general business.

The meeting was called to order by President protem Wilson with the following members present. Gable, Gilson, Love, McDonald, R. E. Morgan, Scott, Wilson. Absent Katgenstein, Seranton, Williams, Zimmerman, W. H. Morgan. Present 7, Absent 3.

On motion of Gable seconded by Scott the reading of the minutes was dispensed with.

Claims Ordinance.

An Ordinance for the payment of Claims was read to Council and Love moved that the Ordinance be placed on its passage seconded by Scott, the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gable, Gilson, Love, McDonald, R. E. Morgan, Scott, Wilson, yeas 7 nays none and the Ordinance was declared passed.

Street work suspended.

Gilson moved that the Street Commissioners be instructed to suspend work on the Streets and Alleys unless ordered by Council, as there was no money in the Treasury to pay for the same seconded by Gable and carried.

Fire Chief forbid contracting Bills against the City.

Scott moved that the Fire Chief be forbid Contracting any Bills against the City unless the same be ordered by the City Council seconded by Gable and carried.

Bid for the construction of Sidewalks.

The following bid for the construction of Sidewalks in the City of Alliance for a period of one year was presented by E. L. Miller.
Excavating 30¢ per cubic yd.

Cinders 50cts per cubic yd.
 Gravel or Sand \$1.00 per cubic yd.
 Canton Brick hard burned \$12.00 per thousand
 Malvern " " " \$11.50 " "
 Flagstone 2 inches thick Linsville or Cleveland 12 cents
 per square foot.
 Trees removed will be extra.

Contract awarded to E. L. Miller Scott moved that the foregoing bid of E. L. Miller for the construction of Sidewalks be accepted and the contract ~~awarded~~ be awarded to him, seconded by Gable, the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gable, Gilson, Love, McDonald, R. E. Morgan, Scott, Wilson, yeas 7, nays none, and the contract was declared awarded to E. L. Miller.

Scott moved that as soon as the contract is signed, that the City Clerk be instructed to order E. L. Miller to construct all sidewalks that have been ordered by Council seconded by Gilson and carried.
 On motion of Gable seconded by Scott Council adjourned.
