

An Ordinance

To authorize the Mayor and Clerk of the Incorporated Village of Alliance, Ohio, to issue the Bonds of Said Village for the purpose of extending the time of payment of the bonded debt of Said Village due March 2nd 1887

Sec 1 Be it ordained and enacted by the Council of the Incorporated Village of Alliance Ohio that the Mayor and Clerk of Said Village be and they are hereby authorized and instructed to issue the bonds of Said Village amounting to \$4,000. for the purpose of extending the time of payment of the bonded debt of Said Village due March 2nd 1887

Sec 2 Said bonds shall be issued in sums of not less than \$100.00 and not to exceed \$1,000.00 and shall become due not to exceed three years from their date and shall bear interest at a rate not to exceed six percent per annum payable semi-annually the principal and interest of said bonds to be paid at the Office of the Treasurer of Said Village; said bonds shall have interest coupons attached and be authenticated by the signatures of the Mayor & Clerk of Said Village and each bond and coupon shall bear on its face the imprint of the seal of Said Village

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An Ordinance

To provide for the grading and improving of Main Street between Arch Street and West Side of Mechanic Street

Section 1 Be it Ordained and Enacted by the Common Council of the Incorporated Village of Alliance Ohio - two thirds of all the Members Concurring - That Main Street, between Arch Street and West Side of Mechanic Street be graded to the Established grade, drained and paved and the Sidewalks Curbed with Suitable Curbing Stones, According to the plans and Specifications on file in the Office of the Village Clerk.

Section 2 That the Cost and Expenses of said improvement, Excepting the Cost and Expense of grading and paving all streets and Allies intersecting Main Street between the points aforesaid, Shall be Estimated, levied and Assessed upon Each and Every front of the Several lots or parcels of land bounding or abutting upon said Street between the points aforesaid, in proportion to the frontage in each.

Section 3 That the Cost of grading and paving all streets and Alleys intersecting upon ^{Said} Main Street between the points aforesaid, Shall paid out of the general Tax Levied for the use of the Corporation.

Sec 4 That all Claims for damages Caused by reason of said improvement Shall be adjusted after Completion of same.

Sec 5 That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force when ten days shall have elapsed after its passage and due Publication

An Ordinance

To Authorize the Mayor and Clerk of the Incorporated Village of Alliance Ohio to issue the Bonds of Said Village for the purpose of Extending the time of payment of the bonded debt of Said Village due Sept 1st 1887.

Section 1. Be it ordained and enacted by the Council of the Incorporated Village of Alliance O That the Mayor and Clerk of Said Village be, and they are hereby Authorized and Empowered to issue the bonds of Said Village amounting in the aggregate to Nine Thousand one Hundred and fifty (\$9,150.00) Dollars for the purpose of Extending the time of the payment of the bonded debt of Said Village due Sept 1st 1887.

Section 2 Said bonds shall be issued in sums of not less than One Hundred dollars and not to exceed One Thousand dollars, and shall be issued for a period not to exceed three years and shall bear interest at a rate not to exceed six per centum payable semi-annually, the Principal and interest of Said bonds to be paid at the office of the Treasurer of Said Village. Said bonds shall have interest Coupons attached and be authenticated by the Signatures of the Mayor & Clerk of Said Village.

Section 3 This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force when ten days shall have elapsed from its passage and ~~the~~ ^{first} publication.

To Levy and Assess a Certain Special Tax on Main Street between the West Side of Arch Street and the West Side of Mechanic Street

Section 1 Be it ordained and Enacted by the Common Council of the Incorporated Village of Alliance County of Stark and State of Ohio Two thirds of All the Members Concurring - that the Sum of Five and Eighty five hundred the Dollars (\$585) be and the Same is hereby levied and Assessed upon Each and Every foot of the Several lots or parcels of Land bounding or abutting upon Main Street between the West Side of Arch Street and the West Side of Mechanic Street for the purpose of paying the Cost and Expense of grading Curbing, paving, draining and improving Street between the points Aforesaid

Sec 2 That the Owners of the Several lots or parcels of Land bounding or abutting upon Main Street between the points Aforesaid Shall pay the Several Amounts of Money from them severally due in that behalf to the Village Treasurer on or before the first day of March A D 1888 or be Subject to the Penalty and interest allowed by law against them severally if not paid at the time and to the person therein designated.

- Section 1. Be it ordained and enacted by the Commar Council of the Incorporated Village of Alliance County of Stark and State of Ohio, that the Mayor and Clerk of the Said Village of Alliance be and they are hereby authorized in Anticipation of a Special Assessment hereunto heretofore made for the purpose of defraying the Expense of grading draining, paving Curbing and improving Main Street between the west Side of Arch Street and the West Side of Mechanic Street and empowered to issue bonds of the Incorporated Village of Alliance to the Amount of Forty two hundred and twelve (\$4212) Dollars. Said bonds Shall be designated "West Main Street Improvment bonds" The Shall be Signed by the Mayor and be Counter Signed by the Clerk of Said Village and Shall bear upon their face the impress of the Village Seal. Said bonds Shall be each for a Sum not Exceeding One Thousand dollars; Shall bear interest at a rate not Exceeding Six percent per Annum payable Semi Annually Principial and interest payable at the Office of the Village Treasurer of Alliance Ohio Said bonds Shall be redeemable at a period not to Exceed three Years from the respective Dates thereof,
- Section 2 That for the payment of the principal and interest of Said bonds at Maturity the real and personal property and faith of the Village aforesaid are hereby pledged.

- Thence west 100 feet to an elevation of 99 feet;

- Thence west 400 feet to an elevation of 117.35 feet;
- Thence west 200 feet to an elevation of 120.85 feet;
- Thence west 900 feet to an elevation of 124 feet;
