

Alliance Chur July 17th 1899.

The Alliance City Council met in regular session with President Morgan in the chair and the following members present Gabler, Gilson, Katzenstein, Love, R. E. Morgan, Scott, Seranton, Williams, Wilson, Zimmerman, Absent McDonald, Present 11, Absent 1.

The Minutes of the two preceding meetings was read and approved

Mayor's Report.

The Mayor's report for the month of June was read showing Taxes and Licenses amounting to \$216.00 collected during the month and on motion of Gabler seconded by Gilson the report was accepted and ordered placed on file.

Cemetery Directors Report.

The Cemetery Directors report for Quarter ending June 30th 1899 was presented and read to Council showing

Gilson moved that the foregoing report of the Alliance Cemetery Directors be accepted and ordered placed on file seconded by Wilson and carried.

Resolution from Board of Health.

A Resolution from the Alliance Board of Health was read asking Council to carefully scrutinize the record of the passage of the Ordinance creating the Board of Health of this City passed June 11th 1875 and see if the passage of said Ordinance is defective or not.

Love moved that the matter referred to in the foregoing Resolution from the Board of Health be referred to the City Solicitor seconded by Seranton and carried.

Fire Chiefs Report for June.

The Fire Chiefs Report for the month of June was read to Council and Gabler moved that the report be accepted and ordered placed on file seconded by Williams and carried.

St Commissioner to repair Main St.

On motion of R. E. Morgan, ^{see by Gabler} the Street Commissioner was instructed to make some necessary repairs on East Main Street.

Lime Stone to be unloaded.

On motion of Love seconded by Zimmerman the Fire Committee was instructed to have care of

crushed Limestone unloaded.

Sewer on Park
Avenue.

Seranton moved that the condition of the storm water sewer on Park Avenue be referred to the Sewer Committee seconded by Gable and carried.

Clerk to notify
Sanitary Police.

On motion of Gable seconded by Wilson the City Clerk was instructed to notify the Sanitary Police to disconnect the sewer running from the John Cook Property to the Webb street sewer.

purchase supplies

Gable moved that the Fire Committee be authorized to purchase ^{necessary} supplies to the amount of \$1200 seconded by Williams and carried.

Scott moved that the Clerk be instructed to prepare a statement of the cost of running the Fire Department for the last three months and compare it with the cost for running the same for the 3 months prior, seconded by R. E. Morgan and carried.

Clerk to notify

lay certain walks.

Scott moved that the Clerk be instructed to notify E. L. Miller not to lay sidewalk along Mrs Daugh's Lots on South Arch Avenue seconded by Wilson and carried.

Solicitor to prepare
sidewalk Resolution.

On motion of Scott seconded by Wilson the Solicitor was instructed to prepare a Resolution to construct a sidewalk along Mrs Daugh's ^{on South Arch Ave} Lots by assessing the cost of the same on both sides of the street, and the Engineer to prepare plans and specifications for the same.

On motion of Zimmerman seconded by Scott the Mayor was instructed to enforce the Ordinance regulating the trimming of trees in the City of Alliance.

An Ordinance to assess a special tax upon the lots and lands abutting upon East Broadway street from the East line of South Arch Avenue to the west line of South Webb Avenue in the City of Alliance, Ohio was read to Council the first time, and Scott moved that the rules be suspended and the Ordinance be read the second time seconded by Zimmerman the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gable, Gilson, Katzenstein, Love, R. E. Morgan, Scott, Seranton, Williams, Wilson, Zimmerman, W. H. Morgan. yeas 11 nays none, the rules were declared

suspended and the Ordinance was read the second time. Scott moved that the rules be again suspended and the Ordinance be read the third time seconded by Williams, the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gable, Gilson, Katzenstein, Love, P. E. Morgan, Scott, Scranton, Williams, Wilson, Zimmerman, W. H. Morgan yeas 11 nays none, the rules were declared suspended and the Ordinance was read the third time, Scott moved that the Ordinance be placed on its final passage seconded by Williams the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gable, Gilson, Katzenstein, Love, P. E. Morgan, Scott, Scranton, Williams, Wilson, Zimmerman, W. H. Morgan, yeas 11, nays none, and the Ordinance was declared passed.

East Broadway
Paving rejected.

Scott stated to Council that the East Broadway Street Paving was unsatisfactory to the Street Committee and moved that the same be rejected by the Council seconded by Katzenstein the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gable, Gilson, Katzenstein, Love, Scott, Scranton, Williams, Wilson, Zimmerman, W. H. Morgan yeas 10 nays none and the motion was declared carried.

A. Resolution to construct sidewalks was read as follows:

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance, Ohio, that a Brick sidewalk shall be constructed on the south side of East College street from the East line of Union Avenue to the east line of Out Lot number 246; also from the west line of Out Lot number 250 to the east line of said Out Lot. and also from the west line of Out Lot number 253 to the east line of City lot number 1833 in accordance with the laws and Ordinances of said City, regulating the construction of such walks, and the plans and specifications for the same now on file in the Office of the City Civil Engineer and within the time limited by law. And the Mayor of said City is hereby required to cause notice of the passage of this resolution to be served upon the owner of each parcel of land abutting upon said sidewalk, in the manner required by law, and the same shall be returned to the Clerk of said City to be by

him preserved as provided by law.

 Alley, to the west line of the property now owned by
 George Hall, in accordance with the laws and Ordinances
 of said City, regulating the construction of such walks, and
 the plans and specifications for the same now on file in
 the office of the City Civil Engineer and within the time
 limited by law. And the Mayor of said City is hereby
 required to cause notice of the passage of this resolution
 to be served upon the owner of each parcel of land abutting
 upon said sidewalk, in the manner required by law,
 and the same shall be returned to the Clerk of the said
 City to be by him preserved as provided by law.

 from the north line of City Lot number 429 to the
 south line of said lot in accordance with the laws
 and Ordinances of said City, regulating the construction
 of such walks, and the plans and specifications for the
 same now on file in the office of the City Civil Engineer
 and within the time limited by law. And the Mayor of
 said City is hereby required to cause notice of the
 passage of this resolution to be served upon the owner

of each parcel of land abutting upon said sidewalk, in the manner required by law, and the same shall be returned to the Clerk of the said City to be by him preserved as provided by law.

Hamlin to the east line of Lincoln Avenue in accordance with the laws and Ordinances of said City, regulating the

construction of such walks, and the plans and specifications for the same now on file in the office of the City Civil Engineer and within the time limited by law. And the Mayor of said City is hereby required to cause notice of the passage of this resolution to be served upon the owner of each parcel of land abutting upon said sidewalk, in the manner required by law, and the same shall be returned to the Clerk of the said City to be by him preserved as provided by law.

Katzenstein moved that the foregoing resolution be adopted seconded by Wilson, the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gable, Gilson, Katzenstein, Lovv, R. E. Morgan, Scott, Scranton, Williams, Wilson, Zimmerman, W. H. Morgan, yeas 11 nays none and the resolution was declared adopted.

Resolution to
construct Sanitary
Sewers Nos 16-34.

A. Resolution to construct Lateral Sanitary Sewers No 16 and 34 and Main Sanitary Sewer No 16.

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance, Ohio, that it is hereby declared necessary to make certain improvements by excavating and laying sewer pipes according to plans and specifications and profiles relating to the same now on file in the City engineers office along the following streets; Commencing on South Union Avenue at the Center of Grant Street, thence south along the center of South Union Avenue to the north line of Milner Street, and also commencing at the center of Simpson St, thence south along the center of South Union Avenue to the center of College Street, bring lateral Sanitary Sewer No. 16; also commencing at the center of South Union Avenue, thence west along the center of College Street to Cullman Avenue, bring lateral Sanitary sewer No. 34; also commencing at the north line of Milner Street, thence south along the center of South Union Avenue to the center of Simpson Street, bring Main Sanitary Sewer No 16.

That the cost and expense of said improvement shall be assessed per front foot upon the lots and lands abutting on said improvement according to the laws and Ordinances on the subject of assessments and shall be payable in three annual installments and bonds shall be issued in anticipation of the collection of such assessments.

That the Clerk is hereby instructed to cause this resolution to be published for two weeks in a newspaper published and of general circulation in the corporation. Wilson moved that the foregoing Resolution be adopted seconded by Gable the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gable, Gilson, Katzenstein, Love, R. E. Morgan, Scott, Seranton, Williams, Wilson, Zimmerman, W. H. Morgan, yeas 11, nays none and the resolution was declared adopted.

On motion of Gable seconded by Scott Council adjourned.
