

Alliance Ohio August 7th 1899.

The Alliance City Council met in regular session in the City Hall with President Morgan in the chair and the following members present. Gable, Gilson, Katzgruber, Lorr, McDonald, R. B. Morgan, Scott, Seranton, Wilson, Zimmerman, W. H. Morgan, Absent Williams. present 11, absent 1.

The minutes of the preceding meeting was read and approved.

Mayor's Report.

Mayor Russler's report for the month July 1899, was presented and read to Council showing fines and Licenses collected during the month to the amount of \$229.00, and on motion of Scott seconded by Gable the report was accepted and ordered placed on file.

Petition to improve
West State Street.

A. Petition for the improvement of West State St was read to Council and Wilson moved that the petition be received and the Civil Engineer be instructed to prepare plans and specifications for the improvement of said street, seconded by Scott and carried.

Petition to improve
Ely Street.

A. Petition for the improvement of Ely Street between Park and Mechanic Avenues was read to Council, and on motion of Lorr seconded by Wilson the same was referred to the Street Committee and Civil Engineer.

Fire Chief's Report.

Fire Chief W. S. Cungat presented his report for the month of July 1899, and on motion of Gable seconded by Gilson the report was accepted and ordered placed on file.

Ordinance for
payment of claims.

An Ordinance for the payment of Claims was read to Council and Lorr moved that the Ordinance be placed on its passage seconded by Scott, the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gable, Gilson, Katzgruber, Lorr, McDonald, R. B. Morgan, Scott, Seranton, Wilson, Zimmerman, W. H. Morgan, yeas 11 nays none and the Ordinance was declared passed.

Broadway Paving.

Wilson moved that the condition of the East Broadway paving be referred to the Street Committee, Finance Committee and Civil Engineer to make an estimate of

the cost to place the paving in proper condition and report the same to the City Solicitor, seconded by Scott and carried.

North Walnut Ave.

On motion of Love seconded by Gable the condition of the Hill on North Walnut Ave was referred to the Street Committee to report on same at the next regular meeting.

Drainage on Prospect St.

On motion of Gable seconded by Scott the drainage on Prospect Street between Linden and Freedom Avenues was referred to the Sewer Committee.

Drainage at corner of Arch & Prospect sts.

On motion of Zimmerman seconded by Scott the drainage at the intersection of Arch Avenue and Prospect St was referred to the Sewer Committee.

Cellar Drains

Love moved that the complaints with reference to cellar drains be referred to the Street Committee and Civil Engineer to make a report on same to Council, seconded by Wilson and carried.

To Create Alley on S. Union Ave.

Wilson moved that the City Civil Engineer be authorized to vacate the alley between Lots no 2111 and 2112 on South Union Avenue, if Sarah Grant will agree to pay the full assessment along Lot No 2112 for the improvement of South Union Ave, and the parties interested in vacating said alley, to pay the full assessment for the improvement of South Union Ave along said alley, seconded by Zimmerman and carried.

Opening Alley in 2nd ward.

On motion of R. E. Morgan seconded by Wilson the opening of the first alley west of N. Webb Avenue and north of Keystone St was referred to the platting committee.

Street Sweeper.

Gable moved that matter of the City purchasing a Street Sweeper be referred to the Street and Finance Committees

Board of Health Ordinance.

An Ordinance to Establish a Board of Health and to Repeal certain Ordinances heretofore passed for that purpose was read to Council the first time, & Scott moved that the rules be suspended and the Ordinance be read the second time, seconded by Wilson the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gable, Wilson, Katzenstein, Love, McDonald, R. And the Mayor of said City is hereby required to cause notice of the passage of this resolution to be served upon the owner of each parcel of land abutting upon said sidewalk, in the manner required by law, and the same shall be returned to the Clerk of the said City to be by him preserved as provided by law.
