A communication from the Alliance, Sebring & Salem Electric Railway Co was read, requesting permission to construct, maintain and operate a street railway in the City of Alliance, over certain streets and parts of streets and also over the east Main street Viaduct.

Scott moved that the petition of the Alliance, Sebring & Salem Electric Railway Co be received with the exception of the right of way over the East Main street Viaduct seconded by Gable.

Love moved to amend the above motion of Mr. Scotts by receiving the petition of the Alliance, Sebring & Salem Electric Railway Co as read seconded by Williams the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gilson, Katzenstein, Love, Williams, Zimmerman, nays Gable, McDonald, R. E. Morgan, Scott, Wilson, yeas 5 nays 5; and the amendment was declared lost.

The yeas and nays were called upon the Original motion of Mr. Scott, ^{as amended} resulting yeas Gable, Scott, nays Gilson, Katzenstein, Love, McDonald, R. E. Morgan, Williams, Wilson, Zimmerman, yeas 2 nays 8 and the motion was declared lost.
