

Alliance Ohio August 21<sup>st</sup> 1899.

Alliance City Council met in regular session in City Hall with President Protem Wilson in the Chair and the following members present, Gilson, Katzenstein, Love, McDonald, R. E. Morgan, Scott, Zimmerman, Absent Gabel, Scranton, Williams, W. H. Morgan. Present 8, Absent 4.

Minutes of two preceding meetings read and approved.

Communication  
from Mary and  
Sarah Grant.

A communication was presented and read to Council signed by Mary Grant and Sara Grant with reference to vacating an Alley on the east side of South Union<sup>ave</sup>, along the north side of City Lot No 2112, and Scott moved that the matter be referred to the City Civil Engineer and City Solicitor with power to act seconded by Gilson, the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gilson, Katzenstein, Love, McDonald, R. E. Morgan, Scott, Wilson, Zimmerman, yeas 8, nays none, and the motion was declared passed.

Communication  
from Board of Health

A Communication from the Board of Health was read to Council with reference to improper drainage at a number of places in the City and on motion of Love seconded by Katzenstein the matter was referred to the Committee on Streets and Alleys.

Petition to  
Grade Alley.

The following Petition was presented to Council. We the undersigned Petitioners request permission of your honorable body to place a grade that portion of first Alley South of Main Street laying between Arch Avenue and first Alley west of same. Expense of same to be paid by petitioners. Said work to be done under direction of Engineer and Grade Committee. Further that if said request is granted the Engineer be directed to set the stakes for said grading at once. The above Petition was signed by H. A. Bailey, J. H. Trussel, C. E. Hudson, F. E. Hartzell, R. E. Williams.

Scott moved that the foregoing Petition be accepted and the request granted seconded by Zimmerman and declared carried.

Requisition  
on Fire Chief.

A Requisition from Fire Chief for Supplies etc was presented to Council and on motion of Zimmerman seconded by Gilson the same was referred to the Fire Committee.

Flush Public  
Square.

Love moved that the City Clerk be instructed to notify the Fire Chief to flush the Public Square twice a week seconded by Zimmerman and carried.

Supplies for St  
Commissioner.

On motion of Scott seconded by Love the Street Commissioner was authorized to purchase 3 shovels and one stone pick.

Seranton Bros  
granted use of Alley.

Love moved that Seranton Bros be granted permission to close the first Alley west of Linden Ave. between Main Street and first Alley south of Main Street, while they are repairing the Old M. E. Church Building, seconded by Scott and carried.

Fill on East  
Grant Street.

Love moved that the matter of making a fill on East Grant Street between Seneca and S. Liberty Avenue be referred to the Street Committee and Engineer to report an estimate of the cost of same at the next meeting seconded by Gilson and carried.

North Walnut  
Avenue Hill.

Gilson moved that the Street Committee be requested to report an estimate of the cost of placing the North Walnut Ave hill in proper condition to the Council at the next regular meeting, seconded by Katgenstein and carried.

Plans to grade  
Columbia St.

On motion of Scott seconded by Gilson the Engineer was instructed to prepare plans and specification for grading Columbia Street from Mechanic Avenue to South Union Avenue.

Railroad Crossings.

R. E. Morgan moved that the Pennsylvania R. R. Co be requested to place Watchmen and Lights at all Railroad Crossings within the City limits, seconded by M. S. Donald.

Love moved that the foregoing motion of R. E. Morgan be amended by instructing the City Clerk to request the Pennsylvania Co to place a Watchman at the Park Avenue crossing, one at the Broadway crossing and one additional watchman at the Freedom Avenue crossing seconded by Scott and declared carried.

The Original motion as amended was then voted upon and declared carried.

Side Track for  
Spoke Factory.

On motion of Love seconded by Katgenstein the Commission on Streets and Alleys and City Solicitor was authorized to grant the C. & P. R. R. Co and the Stum Spoke Factory permission to lay a side track along the first east of

North Union Avenue from the C. & P. R. R. south to the first alley south of Keystone street, said track to be laid so as not to interfere with traffic along said alley between the points named.

On motion of Scott seconded by Love the Clerk was instructed to notify the Board of Health that after the month of August 1899, there would be no funds with which to pay the Sanitary Policeman.

On motion of Love seconded by Gilson the Solicitor was instructed to prepare a Resolution to construct a Lateral Sanitary sewer on South Union Avenue from Grant street to College street, thence west on College street to Aultman Ave.

Gilson moved that the Building & Grounds Com be authorized to contract for grading around the new Residence at the Sewage Disposal Works, seconded by Scott and carried.

On motion of Scott seconded by Gilson Council adjourned.
