The Alliance City Council met special session upon the following call.

You are hereby notified that a special meeting of the Council, of the City of Alliance, Ohio, will be held in the City Hall, of the said City, on Wednesday evening, September 6th, 1899, at 7-30 O'clock.

The meeting was called to order by President protem Thomas Wilson and the following named members being present, Gable, Gilson, Love, McDonald, Scott, Seranton, Williams, Zimmerman, absent Katzstein, R. E. Morgan, W. H. Morgan, Present 9, absent 3.

The minutes of the preceding meeting was read and approved.

Claims Ordinance

An Ordinance for the payment of Claims was presented and read to Council and Love moved that the Ordinance be placed on its final passage, seconded by Scott the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gable, Gilson, Love, McDonald, Scott, Seranton, Williams, Wilson, Zimmerman, yeas 9 nays none and the Ordinance was declared passed.

Sullivan Graham
and Kinneer to
file Bond.

On motion of Scott seconded by Love the City Clerk was instructed to hold the amount due Sullivan, Graham & Kinneer on Estimate No 2 until they file the Bond required by the specifications for the improvement of South Union Avenue.

Davis & Archer
to file Bond.

Scott moved that Davis & Archer be permitted to file a Bond in the sum of Two thousand dollars instead of the City retaining 5% for a period of one year seconded by Williams and carried.

On motion of Gable seconded by Scott, Council adjourned.
