

Alliance Ohio September 18<sup>th</sup> 1899.

The Alliance City Council met in regular session in the City Hall. President Morgan and President Protem Wilson being absent. the meeting was called to order by the Clerk, and on motion of Scott seconded by Gable, Mr Wilson was elected chairman of the meeting.

The Roll was called with the following members present Gable, Wilson, Katzenstein, McDonald, Scott, Scranton, Zimmerman, Absent. Lee, R. E. Morgan, Williams, Wilson, H. H. Morgan. Present 7, Absent 5.

Minutes of the preceding meeting was read and approved. Mayor Dressler's Report for the month of August was read to Council showing fines and licenses collected to the amount of \$126.00, and on motion of Scott seconded by Gable the report was accepted and ordered placed on file.

The following communication was read to Council  
To the Honorable City Council,

Alliance, Ohio.

Gentlemen:-

We the undersigned herewith present to you the consent in writing of the owners of more than one half the foot frontage of lots and lands abutting on that part of Patterson street in the City of Alliance between the west line of North Arch Ave and the east Corporation line of the City of Alliance, for the construction, maintenance and operation of an electric railway on said street between the points named. Said railway shall be single track with the necessary switches, sidetracks, turntables, poles, wires and other fixtures and appurtenances required in the construction, maintenance and operation of said Railway.

We respectfully ask your honorable body to take the necessary steps required by law to grant the undersigned Company, its successors and assigns a franchise for the construction, maintenance and operation of said Railway. Said franchise to be for twenty five years from the date the same is granted by your honorable body.

On motion of Zimmerman seconded by Scott the Street Committee was instructed to look after the condition of Grant street near Arch Avenue.

City Civil Engineer Pfouts reported to Council that South Freedom Ave and North Union Avenue were completed according to Contract and on motion of Scott seconded by Gable the report was unanimously accepted.

On motion of W. Donald seconded by Scott the City Solicitor was instructed to notify Supt A. B. Starr to have a tight cover placed under their tracks at the North Union Ave crossing.

Fire Chief W. J. Augst submitted a requisition for supplies and repairs to the amount of \$18.00 and on motion of Gable seconded by Scott the Clerk was instructed to purchase the same.

Fire Chief W. J. Augst submitted his report for the month of August 1899 and on motion of Gable seconded by Scott the report was accepted.

A. Resolution to Construct sidewalks was read to Council for the first time as follows:

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance, Ohio, that a Brick sidewalk shall be constructed on the South side of East Broadway street from the east line of the right of way of the Cleveland & Pittsburgh Rail Road Company to the west line of Meadow Avenue, and also on the west side of Meadow Avenue from the south line of East Broadway street to the north line of Cambridge st. in accordance with the laws and Ordinances of said City, regulating the construction of such walks, and the plans and specifications for the same now on file in the office of the City Civil Engineer and within the time limited by law. And the Mayor of said City is hereby required to cause notice of the passage of this resolution to be served upon the owner of each parcel of land abutting upon said sidewalk, in the manner required by law, and the same shall be returned to the Clerk of the said City to be by him preserved as provided by law.
