

Alliance Ohio October 2nd 1899.

The Alliance City Council met in regular session in the City Hall with President Protem Wilson presiding and the following members present Gable, Love, McDonald, R. E. Morgan, Scott, Scranton, absent Gilson, Katzenstein, Williams, Zimmerman, W. H. Morgan Present 7, absent 5.

Minutes of the preceding meeting was read and approved. Mayor Russlers Report for the month of September 1899 was read to Council showing fines and Licenses collected during the month amounting to \$25.00 and Scott moved that the report be adopted and placed on file seconded by Gable and carried.

Fire Chief William J. Aungst presented his report to Council for the month of September and on motion of Gable seconded by Scott the report was accepted.

A Communication from the Womens Christian Temperance Union of Alliance, Ohio. was presented to Council with reference to the passage of a Curfew Ordinance, and on motion of Love seconded by Scott the communication was received and ordered placed on file.

A. Communication from the Pennsylvania Co stating that they wished to construct a wreck circuit in Alliance, and would like to have the City Council grant them permission to set poles on the following named streets and alleys: two poles on Pike street, three poles on ally between Franklin, and Webb streets, and five poles on the first street east of Franklin street.

Love moved that the above request of the Pennsylvania Co be granted, said work to be done under the supervision of the Committee on Streets and Alleys seconded by R. E. Morgan and declared carried.

An Ordinance for the payment of Claims was read to Council and Scott moved that the Ordinance be placed on its passage and that the Clerk be instructed to retain a sufficient amount from the Claims of Sullivan, Graham & Kinneer and John Duffy to cover the amount of Claims filed against their accounts seconded by Love the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gable, Love, McDonald, R. E. Morgan, Scott, Scranton, Wilson,

Scott moved that the Street Commissioner be instructed to purchase One Keg of spikes seconded by Gable and declared carried.

On motion of Gable seconded by Seranton the Mr. Young Stairway on Prohibition Alley was referred to the City Solicitor and Street Committee to report on the same at the next meeting of Council.

On motion of Seranton seconded by Gable the Contractors on South Union Avenue was instructed to place Oxford street in proper condition as required by the specifications.

City Engineer Pout submitted a report for the grading of Columbia street from Arch Ave to Union Ave and on motion of Scott, seconded by Gable the report was accepted.

City Engineer Pout submitted a report for the grading of Ely street from Park Ave to Mechanic Ave, and on motion of Love seconded by Scott the report was accepted.

Gable moved that the City Clerk be instructed to purchase a store for the Fire Dept, seconded by Seranton and declared carried.

Gable moved that the City Clerk be instructed to advertise for Bids to furnish Coal for the City Hall for the ensuing year seconded by Scott and carried.

Love moved that the City Clerk be instructed to notify William and John Taylor to repair their sidewalks on West Ely street seconded by Gable and declared carried.

A. Resolution to Construct sidewalks of Brick on the south side of East Broadway street from the east line of the right of way of the Cleveland & Pittsburgh Rail Road Company to the west line of Meadow Avenue and also on the west side of Meadow Ave from the south line of East Broadway St to the north line of East Cambridge street was read to Council, this being the second reading of said Resolution.

On motion of Gable seconded by Scott the Engineer was instructed to set grade stakes for sidewalk along W. F. Richards property on the south side of East Patterson street.

Scott moved that the City Solicitor be instructed to prepare an Ordinance to abolish the office of City Marshal seconded by Gable the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gable, Love, McDonald, R. E. Morgan, Scott, Seranton, Wilson, yeas 7 nays none, and the motion was declared carried.

On motion of Gable seconded by Seranton Council adjourned.
