

Alliance Ohio October 16th, 1899.

The Roll was called with the following members present. Gable, Wilson, Ketchum, Love, McDonald, R. E. Morgan, Scott, Williams, Gummerman. Absent, Herenton, Wilson, W. H. Morgan. Present 9, absent 3.

The Alliance City Council met in regular session in the City Hall, President Morgan and President protem Wilson being absent the meeting was called to order by the Clerk and on motion of Scott seconded by Gable, W. W. Wilson was elected president protem of the meeting.

The Minutes of the preceding meeting was read and approved.

Ordinance
Establishing Street
Rail Road Route No. 3.

An Ordinance Establishing a Street Railway route on Patterson Street in the City of Alliance Stark County, Ohio, to be known as Route No. 3. was read to Council the first time, and Scott moved that the rules be suspended and the Ordinance read the second time seconded by Gable, the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gable, Gilson, Katzenstein, Love, McDonald, R. E. Morgan, Scott, Williams, Zimmerman, yeas 9 nays none the rules were declared suspended and the Ordinance was read the second time; Gable moved that the rules be again suspended and the Ordinance be read the third time seconded by Zimmerman, the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gable, Gilson, Katzenstein, Love, McDonald, R. E. Morgan, Scott, Williams, Zimmerman, yeas 9 nays none the rules were declared suspended and the Ordinance was read the third time; (At this time Councilman Thomas Wilson came into Council Chamber and took his seat.)

Gable moved that the Ordinance be placed on its final passage seconded by Scott, the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gable, Gilson, Katzenstein, Love, McDonald, R. E. Morgan, Scott, Williams, Wilson, Zimmerman, yeas 10 nays none and the Ordinance was declared passed.

Resolution
to Improve
Columbia Street.

A. Resolution to Improve East Columbia Street from the East line of South Union Ave to the West line of South Arch Ave in the City of Alliance, Ohio, was read to Council as follows:

Be it resolved by the Council of the City of Alliance, Ohio: That it is hereby declared necessary to improve East Columbia Street from the East line of South Union Avenue to the west line of South Arch Avenue, in the City of Alliance, Ohio, by excavating the roadway to the established grade thereof, in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor now on file in the office of the City Civil Engineer; the cost and expense of such improvement shall be paid by an assessment assessed per front foot upon the lots and lands abutting upon said improvement; said assessment shall be payable in three annual installments, and bonds shall be issued in anticipation of the collection of such assessment.

And the Clerk is hereby directed to cause this resolution to be published for two weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in the corporation, and the City Marshal is hereby appointed to serve notice of the passage of this resolution upon the owners of property abutting upon said improvement who are residents of Stark County, Ohio.

Scott moved that the Resolution to Improve Columbia Street be adopted. seconded by Gable the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gable, Gilson, Katzenstein, Love, McDonald, R. E. Morgan, Scott, Williams, Wilson, Zimmerman yeas 10 nays none and the Resolution was declared adopted.

Property owners to
work on S. Union
Avenue.

Wilson stated to Council that the property owners on South Union Ave, south of State Street had agreed to place the street in proper condition if the City would grant them permission to use the wheel scraper belonging to the City, and moved that the request be granted seconded by Scott and declared carried.

Fill on East
Noble Street.

On motion of Morgan seconded by Gable the necessity of making a fill on East Noble Street near James Sams property was referred to the Street Committee with power to act.

St. Commissioner to
put in Crossing on
Grant Street.

Zimmerman moved that the Street Commissioner be instructed to put a Crossing in on Grant Street

Just East of the O. R. & L. E. R. R. seconded by Scott and declared carried.

A. B. Shilling to vacate Cambridge Street.

Gable moved that A. B. Shilling be notified to vacate Cambridge Street seconded by Scott and carried.

Engineer instructed to build Sanitary Sewer.

Love moved that the Civil Engineer be instructed to build a Lateral Sanitary Sewer commencing at the intersection of the first alley South of Market st and Arch Ave thence south in Arch Ave to the Property owned by Mrs J. N. Ross, seconded by Gable and declared carried.

Drainage at the intersection of Mechanic & Prospect streets.

On motion of Scott seconded by McDonald the Street Commissioner was instructed to fix the drainage at the intersection of Mechanic Ave and Prospect street.

Resolution to construct Walk on Broadway and Meadow Ave

A Resolution to construct Sidewalks of Brick on the South Side of East Broadway street from the east line of the right of way of the Cleveland & Pittsburgh Rail Road Company to the west line of Meadow Avenue and also on the west side of Meadow Avenue from the south line of East Broadway street to the north line of East Cambridge street was read to Council the third time, and Scott moved that the Resolution be placed on its final passage seconded by Zimmerman the yeas and nays were called resulting yeas Gable, Gilson, Katzenstein, Love, McDonald, R. E. Morgan, Scott, Wilson, Zimmerman, yeas 9, nays none, and the Resolution was declared passed.

Voting place in 2nd ward.

On motion of Scott seconded by Gable the voting place in the third ward was changed to the J. M. Fittwell Room on South Liberty Avenue.

Voting place in 1st ward.

On motion of Scott seconded by Gable the voting place in the first ward was changed to the Fogg Room on Mechanic Avenue.

Solicitor to prepare Resolution with reference to Rail Road Crossings.

On motion of Morgan seconded by McDonald the City Solicitor was instructed to prepare a Resolution with reference to better protection at Rail Road crossings in Alliance, said Resolution to be passed upon by Council at the next regular meeting and a copy of the same presented to R. S. Kayler Commissioner of Rail Roads.

Hose for Fire Department.

Gable moved that the matter of purchasing some small hose for the Fire Department be referred to the Finance Committee to report on same at the next
