Mr. B. F. Weybrecht, member of the City Hall Commission, made the following statement regarding the construction of the new City Hall:

"We wanted to keep within the amount appropriated for the City Hall. We expected to receive \$5,000.00 from Lexington Township as its share for the new building, but we understand that the Lexington Township Trustees are unable to fulfill their agreement in this respect. We discovered that the present heating plant was too small, and the one being installed to heat both the city hall and the fire department building will cost about \$2,500.00 additional, consequently we are compelled to ask for an additional sum of \$10,000.00; this to include a new jail to complete the City Hall."

On motion of Knowles, seconded by Binkley, the amount of \$20.00 appropriated for the salary of the Humane Officer, was made \$120.00.


On motion of Grubb, seconded by Ryan, the appropriation for the salary of the Sealer of Weights & Measures, \$40.00, was made \$240.00.


Barnard moved, seconded by Cathon, that the appropriation for regular police be made \$6,291.50. Mr. Heidman voted in the negative.
