The following Ordinance was introduced:

Ordinance No. 1888.

Mr. Heidman: - To amend Rule 1, Section 1, of Ordinance Number 484 entitled, "An ordinance to approve rules and regulations for the construction, alteration and inspection of plumbing placed in, or in connection with any building in the City of Alliance, Ohio, directed by the Board of Health of said City, as amended by Ordinance Number 1643 passed August 25th, 1913. Was read the first time and referred to the Committee on Bridges and Buildings for immediate action.
