

Called meeting of the Village Council, held at Mayor's office on April 9th 1879 - Members of Council all present. Mayor Crubaugh presiding - reading of proceedings of last meeting deferred - The object of the convening of the Council was to hear a communication from a Committee appointed by the Board of Health. The communication was from J. M. Antram and C. St. Hartshorn, and was read by the Clerk, after considerable talk and discussion Henry Linwood moved that there be a committee of two (2) appointed to confer with Elias St. Johnson in relation to the Pond, and see what terms he would sell or lease the Pond to the Corporation, to be used for Reservoir, for Water Privileges for the Borough. John G. Ernst seconded the motion. J. L. Dilworth now moved the resolution be laid on the table, indefinitely - seconded by Mr. Madden, vote Bard yes Ernst No Madden yes, Linwood No Dilworth yes - Motion lost,

Dilworth moved to adjourn seconded by Mr. Madden. - Afterwards with Madden's consent Mr. Dilworth withdrew the motion to adjourn.

The vote on the question of appointing the Committee was now taken and resulted as follows. Bard yes. Linwood yes. Ernst yes. Madden yes. Dilworth yes Motion Carried - "Councilman Boren had returned prior to either of the last two motions." The Mayor appointed as the aforesaid Committee
