

Council Chamber Alliance O Sept 25. 1891

Council met in special session on call of the Mayor for the purpose of taking action on the Linden Avenue improvement and considering sidewalk and street work, with President Wilson presiding and the following members present Brinker Bush Cowan Devine Jenkins Kayler Keplinger Kynett. Love. Absent Conbaugh

On Motion of Brinker seconded by Devine the sidewalk and street committees were instructed to report to Council a plan and an estimate of the cost of sidewalk and sewer on ~~Adrian~~ Linden Avenue immediately north of the R.R. Bridge.

Brinker moved that the bid of W. N. Gilson for the paving of Linden Avenue be accepted (the same having been read the previous meeting) seconded by Bush. Devine moved to lay the motion on the table until Monday evening Sept 28th seconded by Earley. The yeas and nays were called on the motion to lay on the table resulting yeas Devine Earley Jenkins Kynett. Nays Brinker Bush Cowan Kayler Keplinger Love Wilson Yeas 4 Nays 7

The motion was declared lost and the yeas and nays were called on the original motion resulting yeas Brinker Bush Jenkins Keplinger Love Wilson. Nays Devine Earley Cowan Kayler Kynett. Yeas 6 nays 5 and the motion was declared lost.

On Motion Council adjourned.
