

The Canton E-Waste, Tire and Household Hazardous Waste Drop Off Center will expand its hours starting Saturday.

The Recycle Center will be open from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on the second Saturday of each month to accommodate residents of Stark, Tuscarawas and Wayne counties not able to come in during our weekly hours.

The center accepts all electronics, including battery operated items, metals, used batteries, paper, cardboard, plastics No. 1 through No. 7, tires (on and off the rims), and household hazardous waste. Latex paint and tube TVs are not accepted.

There is a limit of 12 tires per person per year. No more than 10 tires can be transported at one time. There are no fees for anything dropped off for recycling.
