


Earley's Hill Park

Surrounded by trees and nestled in a hollow, this 12-acre park is located on the northside where Alliance's earliest citizens settled. In fact, it is directly across the street from the Mabel Hartzel Historic Home, formerly the farmstead of Mathew Earley, for whom the park is named. Earley's features five ballfields, primarily used by youth softball organizations. However, there is more to enjoy, including a playground suited for toddlers, and a walking trail.
