


Alliance Area Testing For COVID-19

Patients should park in the designated parking spots by the Carnation Clinic sign, testing will take place in the patient's vehicle.

To reduce wait time, patients are encouraged to call ahead to schedule their test at 330-596-7127. Patients will be instructed to arrive at a specific time for testing. <i>Patients who are pre-registered and have a scheduled testing time, should immediately enter the testing lane upon arrival.</i> <i>Patients who are not pre-registered should park in one of the designated parking spots in the POB parking lot and call 330-596-7127 to pre-register. Patients who are not preregistered will likely experience a longer wait time for testing.</i> If you are in need of emergent care, please come into the Emergency Department 24 hours a day.
