Aultman Alliance Community Hospital provides round trip transportation to patients who do not have access to/from medical appointments, as long as both the patient and physician are located within the city limits. Advance notice must be given, at least 24hrs, prior to time of appointment. Patients must be self sufficient or have an aide. Family members must accompany patients under the age of 16.

# Transportation Services



Buckeye members are eligible for non-emergency transportation (15 round trips/30 one way trips per 12 month period, per member) to covered healthcare, dental, WIC, and CDJFS appointments. For more information members may call 1-866-246-4358.



CareSource members are eligible for transportation to/from the health partner's office (15 round trips/30 one way trips per year, per member) for trips less than 30 miles. For more information members may call 1-800-488-0134.



Molina members are eligible for non-emergency transportation (24 one-way trips each calendar year, per member) to health care appointments. For more information members may call 1-844-491-4761.



Paramount members are eligible for non-emergency transportation assistance (15 round trips /30 one way trips each calendar year, per member) to health care, pharmacy, WIC and CDJFS appointments and to/from a food bank, grocery store or for grocery delivery. For more information members may call 1-866-837-9817.



UnitedHealthcare members are eligible for transportation (15 round trips/30 one way trips per year, per member) to medical visits or the pharmacy. For more information members may call 1-800-895-2017.

**Proline** provides transportation services to passengers with ADA recognized disabilities throughout the entire county. Once registered with Proline, passengers can schedule rides from 1-4 days in advance.

**Medline** provides non-medical transportation services to those eligible for a Medicaid Waiver through the Board of Development Disabilities for employment, adult day support and vocational training anywhere in Stark County. If interested contact the Medicaid Coordinator at 330-430-1746.
