REQUEST FOR STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS

The City of Alliance Wastewater Treatment Plant intends to contract services to administer the Industrial Pretreatment Program (IPP) as required by the Ohio EPA. Services will include assistance with industrial inspections, self-monitoring and city monitoring data management, regulatory reporting, non-significant industry inventory, local limit revisions and violation enforcement. Entities interested in providing the required services should reply with a Statement of Qualifications (SOQ) no later than 4:00PM EST, on May 23, 2025. For the purposes of this SOQ, the City will accept submissions from a firm, a sole proprietor or collaboration meeting the requirements defined within this document. Statements received after this deadline will not be considered for this project.

SOQ's should include information relevant to administering an IPP program. The SOQ shall include: education and experience of key personnel performing the work (two pages maximum), availability and accessibility of key personnel to work at the WWTP or perform site visits, required engineering license, a 2-page write-up on the understanding of the City's program and requirements of the Ohio Environmental reporting for the IPP, references and/or any previous work performed for the City of Alliance; and other relevant information.

As required by Ohio Revised Code 153.65-71, responding firms will be evaluated and ranked in order of their qualifications. Following this evaluation, the City of Alliance will enter contract negotiations with the highest ranked firm.
