Sealed bids will be received by the City through **4:30 PM on Wednesday October 1, 2014**. Bids must be sent to the City of Alliance Auditor's Office located at 504 East Main Street, Suite 110, Alliance, Ohio 44601 and "Attn: Bid Documents (Regulated Waste Services) – Former Stewart Brothers Paint/Former Volcanic Heater" must be written on the exterior of the envelope. Bids received after this time will not be accepted. The bid opening will occur at **12:00 PM on Friday, October 3, 2014** in the 2nd Floor Conference Room at the City of Alliance Administration Building located at 504 East Main Street, Alliance, Ohio 44601. The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids and will award contracts to the bidder(s) submitting the lowest and best bid(s). A pre-bid meeting will be held on Friday, September 26, 2014 at 10:00 AM at the Former Stewart Brothers Paint property located at 1010 North Union Avenue, Alliance, Ohio.

All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Guaranty in the form of either a Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond for the full amount of the bid (including all add alternates) or a certified check, cashier's check, or an irrevocable letter of credit in an amount equal to 10% of the bid (including all add alternates).

The City of Alliance intends and requires that this project be completed no later than 30-days after signing of contract.

No bidder may withdraw its bid within thirty (30) days after the bid opening. The City reserves the right to waive irregularities in bids, to reject any or all bids, and to conduct such investigation as necessary to determine the lowest and best bidder for each contract.
