**Ordinance 78-09:** Introduced by Okey: An Ordinance to authorize the Fire Department of The City of Alliance, Ohio, to provide Emergency Medical Services at Higher Levels of skill and Certification; and to declare an emergency.

**Second Readings:**

**Ordinance 82-09:** Introduced by Ryan: An Ordinance vacating part of the unnamed alley West of Scranton Avenue between West Cambridge Street and West Summit Street, in the City of Alliance, County of Stark, and State of Ohio; and declaring an emergency.

**Ordinance 83-09:** Introduced by Thompson: An Ordinance accepting and approving the replat of Lots 1965, 1967, 1969, 3931, 3932 and part of a vacated 20 foot unnamed East-West alley between West Cambridge Street and West Summit Street, in the City of Alliance, County of Stark, and State of Ohio; and declaring an emergency.

**Ordinance 87-09:** Introduced by Rhome & Andreani: An Ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Safety and Service to accept a bid from a prior bidding if available or to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for the purpose of purchasing a new sludge applicator truck for the Wastewater Treatment Plant; and declaring an emergency.

**New Business:**

**Ordinance 89-09:** Introduced by Rhome: An Ordinance authorizing and directing the Director of Public Safety and Service to enter into a grant agreement for recycling with the Stark-Tuscarawas-Wayne Joint Solid Waste Management Districe; and declaring an emergency.

**Resolution 90-09:** Introduced by Council as a Whole: A Resolution accepting the amounts and rates as determined by the Budget Commission and Authorizing the necessary tax levies and certifying them to the County Auditor.

**Ordinance 52-08:** Introduced by Ryan: An Ordinance vacating a 20 foot East-West alley between Willow and Mahoning Avenues, a 16 foot North-South alley between Broadway Street and an East-West alley between Willow and Mahoning Avenues, and a Portion of High Street between Willow and Mahoning Avenues in the City of Alliance, County of Stark, and State of Ohio. (Referred Planning Commission on May 19, 2008)

**Ordinance 53-08:** Introduced by Thompson: An Ordinance accepting and approving the replat of lots 1012 through 1020, lots 1045 through 1053, a vacated 20 foot East-West alley between Broadway and Summit Streets, and a vacated portion of High Street between Willow and Mahoning Avenues in the City of Alliance, County of Stark, and State of Ohio. (Referred Planning Commission on May 19, 2008)

**Ordinance 100-08:** Introduced by Okey and Ryan: An Ordinance to require the erection of "Radar Enforced" signs along State Street; and declaring an emergency. (Referred Streets and Alleys Committee on August 4, 2008)

**Ordinance 6-09-S:** Introduced by Okey and Ryan: An Ordinance to enact Chapter 379 of the Codified Ordinances of Alliance, Ohio; to provide a system of inspection for Golf Carts to be operated on streets in the City; and to restrict the operation of Golf Carts to streets where the speed limit does not exceed 25 miles per hour. . (Referred Safety and Judiciary Committee on February 2, 2009)

**Ordinance 26-09:** Introduced by Okey: An Ordinance Ordering the Norfolk and Southern Corporation to repair and maintain its Railroad crossing located on Mahoning Avenue, Immediately North of Railroad Street, in the City of Alliance; and declaring an emergency.

**Ordinance 32-09:** Introduced by Okey: An Ordinance authorizing and directing the Director of Public Safety and Service to submit an application to the Assistance to Firefighters Grant Program of the U.S. Department of Homeland Security and the Federal Emergency Management Agency for the purpose of acquiring grant funds to construct a new fire station that replaces the existing Mount Union Fire Station; and declaring an emergency. (Referred Safety and Judiciary Committee on April 6, 2009)

**Ordinance 55-09:** Introduced by Rhome and Andreani: An Ordinance authorizing and directing the Director of Public Safety and Service to request qualifications and enter into a professional services contract for engineering and design services of integrating Ultraviolet light into the treatment process at the Water Treatment Plant; and declaring an emergency.

**Proclamation:** Introduced by Andreani; A Proclamation urging U.S. Senators Sherrod Brown and George Voinovich to vote against "Cap and Trade." (Tabled July 20, 2009)
