Roll called: Members present - Clark,

Mayor Rice then stated that the meeting
 was called to consider the matter of paving
 the Public Square; at this time Kingsbury
 came in and took his seat in the Council.
 after a long discussion of the question
 Stanley moved that we have the square
 dug out to the depth of 12 inches and
 have it filled 6 inches with gravel and
 cinders, and paved with six inches of good
 solid stone, seconded by Scott, and ^{carried.}

 Monday evening July 9th 1888.
