

Alliance Ohio September 6th 1897.

City Council met in regular session, the President and Vice President being absent the meeting was called to order by the Clerk.

On motion of Wilson seconded by Miller, Mr Trail was elected President Protem.

The Roll was called with the following members present
Kay, King, Lov, Miller, Scott, Trail, Wilson.

On motion of Kay seconded by King the reading of the minutes was dispensed with.

Lov moved that when the Council adjourn it be to meet in one week from tonight seconded by Wilson and carried.

On motion of Lov seconded by Kay the Mayor was requested to call a Citizens meeting Tuesday evening at 7, ³⁰ O'clock in the Mayors Office for the purpose of making arrangements to attend the funeral of the late Thos R. Morgan, Sr.

Kay offered the following Resolution.

Whereas:

This Council has learned with profound regret of the death of our distinguished fellow Citizen, the Hon Thos. R. Morgan, Sr.

Resolved:

That we tender to the family of the deceased assurances of our affectionate sympathy in this hour of bereavement, and

Resolved:

That as a mark of respect to the memory of the deceased this Council do now adjourn and that the members of this Council and the City officials be requested to attend the funeral of the deceased in a body.

King moved the adoption of the Resolution seconded by Wilson and carried.
